SETUP AND INSTALLATION

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing your toner cartridge, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
"Toner Low" or "Replace Toner" message persists after replacement.	Cartridge not seated correctly, protective seal not fully removed, or printer sensor issue.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Remove and reinsert the cartridge, ensuring it clicks into place.◦ Check for any remaining protective seals or tape.◦ Restart the printer.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Faded or light prints.	Toner unevenly distributed, low toner, or print settings issue.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Remove the cartridge and gently shake it horizontally to redistribute toner. ◦ Check toner levels and replace if low. ◦ Adjust print density settings in your printer driver.
Streaks or spots on prints.	Damaged drum, foreign object inside printer, or toner leakage.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Inspect the cartridge drum for damage (avoid touching). ◦ Clean the printer's internal components as per your printer manual. ◦ If the issue persists, the cartridge may be faulty and require replacement.
