Summer Infant Peek Internet Camera System - User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

The Summer Infant Peek Internet Camera System provides parents with the ability to view their baby remotely via the internet on compatible smartphones, laptops, and tablets. This system offers a secure way to connect to your baby from anywhere, providing peace of mind. It is designed for occasional "peeking" and is not intended to replace traditional in-home baby monitors for continuous or overnight monitoring.

This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Internet Camera System.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before using this product. Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or damage.

- **STRANGULATION HAZARD:** Children have been strangled in cords. Keep this cord out of the reach of children (more than 3 feet / 0.9 meters away). Never place camera or cords within 3 feet of the crib.
- This product is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with it.
- This product contains small parts. Adult assembly is required. Exercise care when unpacking and assembling.
- This product is intended for indoor use only.
- Do not use the camera near water (e.g., bathtub, sink, etc.).
- Use only the AC adapters provided. Using other adapters may damage the device.
- Do not touch exposed power cord contacts with sharp or metal objects.
- Ensure proper ventilation. Do not cover the camera or gateway with blankets or other objects.
- Keep the camera and gateway away from heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other appliances that produce heat.
- Clean only with a dry cloth.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4.1 Internet Camera Unit

- **Camera Lens:** Captures video feed.
- **Infrared LEDs:** Provide night vision capability for low-light conditions.
- **Microphone:** Captures audio from the baby's room.
- **Power Indicator Light:** Indicates power status.
- **Power Port:** Connects to the camera's AC power adapter.
- **On/Off Switch:** Controls power to the camera.

4.2 Gateway Unit

- **Power Indicator:** Shows power status.
- **Internet Indicator:** Shows connection status to the internet.
- **Camera Link Indicator:** Shows connection status to the camera.

- **Power Port:** Connects to the gateway's AC power adapter.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to set up your Summer Infant Peek Internet Camera System:

1. **Position the Camera:** Place the camera in a location that provides a clear view of your baby. Ensure it is at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) away from the crib and out of reach of children. The camera can be placed on a flat surface or wall-mounted (mounting hardware not included).
2. **Connect Camera Power:** Plug one end of an AC power adapter into the camera's power port and the other end into a standard electrical outlet. Turn the camera's On/Off switch to the "ON" position. The power indicator light should illuminate.
3. **Position the Gateway:** Place the gateway unit near your home internet router.
4. **Connect Gateway to Router:** Use the provided Ethernet cable to connect the Ethernet port on the gateway unit to an available LAN port on your home internet router.
5. **Connect Gateway Power:** Plug the second AC power adapter into the gateway's power port and the other end into a standard electrical outlet. The power indicator light on the gateway should illuminate.
6. **Wait for Connection:** Allow a few minutes for the gateway to establish a connection. The Internet Indicator and Camera Link Indicator lights on the gateway should turn solid, indicating successful connections.
7. **Register Your Product Online:**
 - Open a web browser on your computer or mobile device.
 - Navigate to the official Summer Infant internet viewing website (refer to the packaging or included documentation for the exact URL).
 - Follow the on-screen instructions to register your product. You will need to create a private and secure username and password.
 - **Important Note:** Product registration is essential for accessing the internet viewing functionality. If you encounter difficulties with website access or registration, please refer to the Troubleshooting section or contact Summer Infant customer support.
8. **Download the App (Optional):** For smartphone or tablet viewing, download the free Summer Infant app from your device's app store (e.g., Apple App Store, Google Play Store).

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your system is set up and registered, you can begin viewing your baby remotely.

6.1 Viewing on a Computer/Laptop

1. Open your web browser and go to the Summer Infant internet viewing website.
2. Log in using your registered username and password.
3. Select your camera from the available devices to begin viewing the live feed.

6.2 Viewing on a Smartphone/Tablet

1. Open the Summer Infant app on your device.
2. Log in using your registered username and password.
3. Select your camera to view the live feed.

6.3 Sharing Access

The system allows you to share access with trusted friends and family. Refer to the online platform or app for instructions on how to invite and manage shared users.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Disconnect both the camera and gateway from power before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the surfaces. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, disconnect all cables and store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Cables:** Regularly inspect power cords for any damage. Do not use if cords are frayed or damaged.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No video feed / Cannot connect to camera.	Camera or gateway not powered on. Gateway not connected to router. Internet connection issue. Camera and gateway not linked.	Ensure both camera and gateway are plugged in and turned on. Check power indicator lights. Verify Ethernet cable is securely connected between gateway and router. Check your home internet connection. Ensure Camera Link Indicator on gateway is solid. If not, try power cycling both units.
Cannot register product or access website.	Incorrect website URL. Temporary server issue. Product registration system changes.	Double-check the website URL provided in the product packaging or quick start guide. Try again after some time. If persistent issues with registration or website access occur, it is recommended to contact Summer Infant customer support directly for the most up-to-date information and assistance.
Poor video quality or lag.	Weak Wi-Fi signal. Internet bandwidth limitations. Too many devices on network.	Ensure gateway is close to your router. Reduce other internet activity on your network. Check your internet service provider's speed.
