# Giro Mens Zero II Short Finger Cycling Gloves User Manual

Model: Zero II (7068730)

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Giro Zero II Short Finger Cycling Gloves are designed for optimal performance and comfort during cycling. Featuring a Super Fit three-panel palm design and Pittards Microvent leather, these gloves offer enhanced grip and breathability. The top is constructed from a breathable, moisture-absorbing mesh with four-way stretch for a secure and comfortable fit. An absorbent microfiber surface is included for sweat management, and integrated Sonic pull tabs assist with easy removal.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

- **Super Fit Three-Panel Palm:** Engineered for a precise, comfortable fit that eliminates bunching.
- **Pittards Microvent Leather Palm:** Enhances grip and provides superior breathability.
- **Breathable Mesh Upper:** Moisture-wicking and elastic for optimal ventilation and flexibility.
- **Absorbent Microfiber Surface:** Conveniently located for wiping away sweat.
- **Integrated Sonic Pull Tabs:** Designed for easy removal of the gloves after use.
- **Short Finger Design:** Provides dexterity and ventilation for warm weather cycling.

## 3. SETUP AND FITTING

To ensure optimal comfort and performance, proper fitting of your Giro Zero II gloves is essential.

1. **Select Correct Size:** Refer to the size chart (S: 178-203 mm, M: 203-229 mm, L: 229-248 mm, XL: 248-267 mm) to choose the size that best matches your hand circumference. A snug fit without restricting movement is ideal.
2. **Donning the Gloves:** Gently slide your hand into each glove, ensuring your fingers are fully seated in their respective openings.
3. **Adjust for Comfort:** The elastic mesh upper and Super Fit palm are designed to conform to your hand. Ensure there is no excess material bunching in the palm or between fingers.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These gloves are designed to enhance your cycling experience by providing grip, comfort, and protection.

- **Grip Enhancement:** The Pittards Microvent leather palm provides excellent grip on handlebars, even in damp conditions.
- **Sweat Management:** Utilize the absorbent microfiber surface on the thumb area to wipe away sweat from your face or brow during rides.
- **Impact Absorption:** While lightweight, the palm design offers a degree of cushioning against road vibrations.
- **Removal:** After your ride, use the integrated Sonic pull tabs located on the fingers to gently remove the gloves. Avoid pulling excessively on the fabric to prevent damage.

## 5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and performance of your Giro Zero II gloves.

- **Washing:** Hand wash only. Use cold water and a mild detergent. Do not use bleach or harsh chemicals.
- **Drying:** Air dry flat. Do not tumble dry, iron, or dry clean. Avoid direct sunlight or high heat, which can damage the leather and elastic materials.
- **Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Stain Prevention:** Be aware that the dye in some gloves, especially new ones, may transfer to hands or other fabrics when wet. Washing before first use may help mitigate this.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Gloves feel too tight or uncomfortable.	Incorrect size selected.	Ensure you have selected the correct size based on the size chart. Gloves should be snug but not restrictive.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Dye transfer to hands or other clothing.	Excess dye from manufacturing, especially when wet.	Hand wash gloves thoroughly before first use. Avoid washing with light-colored items. This issue may diminish over time with repeated washing.
Material tearing or showing excessive wear.	Improper removal technique; excessive force during use; normal wear and tear.	Always use the integrated pull tabs for removal. Avoid snagging gloves on sharp objects. While durable, gloves are subject to wear over time.
