INTRODUCTION

The Yamaha YSP-5600BL is a 7.1.2-channel Dolby Atmos MusicCast Sound Bar designed to elevate your home audio experience. It utilizes advanced Digital Sound Projector technology with 46 speaker drivers to deliver immersive multi-dimensional sound, including overhead effects for Dolby Atmos and DTS:X content. This sound bar also integrates with the MusicCast wireless multiroom audio system, allowing for flexible audio distribution throughout your home.

Key features include:

- World's first sound bar with 7.1.2 channel multi-dimensional sound.
- HDMI inputs with 4K Ultra HD pass-through and HDCP 2.2 for high-quality video.
- MusicCast wireless multiroom audio system for whole-home audio.
- Access to popular music streaming services like Pandora, Spotify, and Rhapsody.
- Versatile connectivity options including Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, AirPlay, and Spotify Connect.
- Works with Alexa for convenient voice control (Alexa device sold separately).

SETUP

Setting up your YSP-5600BL involves connecting it to your television and power, and then configuring its network and audio settings. For optimal performance, ensure the sound bar is placed in an open area, ideally below your TV, to allow sound beams to reflect effectively off walls and the ceiling.

Initial Connections

1. Connect your TV to the sound bar's HDMI ARC/eARC port using a high-speed HDMI cable.
2. Connect your media devices (Blu-ray player, game console, etc.) to the sound bar's HDMI input ports.
3. Plug the sound bar into a power outlet.

Network and Audio Configuration

The YSP-5600BL features Wi-Fi connectivity for MusicCast and streaming services. Download the Yamaha MusicCast Controller app on your smartphone or tablet to guide you through the network setup and YPAO (Yamaha Parametric Acoustic Optimizer) sound calibration. YPAO automatically adjusts sound parameters to suit your room's acoustics, ensuring the best possible surround sound experience.

For enhanced bass, you can wirelessly connect an optional powered subwoofer using the SWK-W16 Wireless Subwoofer Kit (sold separately).

OPERATING

The YSP-5600BL offers various ways to control your audio experience, from the included remote control to the intuitive MusicCast app.

Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** Use the power button on the sound bar or the remote control.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust volume using the remote or the MusicCast app. The sound bar can also be configured to respond to your TV remote's volume control via HDMI CEC.
- **Input Selection:** Switch between HDMI inputs, optical, coaxial, or network sources using the remote or app.

MusicCast App Control

The MusicCast app provides comprehensive control over your YSP-5600BL and other MusicCast devices. Through the app, you can:

- Browse and play music from connected streaming services (Pandora, Spotify, Rhapsody, SiriusXM, etc.).
- Access music stored on your network-attached storage (NAS) or computer.
- Link multiple MusicCast devices for synchronized multiroom audio playback.
- Adjust detailed sound settings, including sound programs and beam modes.

Sound Beam Technology

The YSP-5600BL uses a sophisticated array of speakers to project sound beams that reflect off your room's walls and ceiling, creating a true surround sound field without the need for multiple physical speakers.

Different sound programs are available to optimize the audio for various content types (e.g., Movie, Music, Sports) and room configurations.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Yamaha YSP-5600BL Sound Bar.

Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the sound bar with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use liquid cleaners, abrasive cleaners, or chemical solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- Keep the speaker grilles free of dust and debris to maintain sound quality.

Software Updates

Periodically check for firmware updates via the MusicCast app or Yamaha's official website. Updates can provide new features, performance improvements, and bug fixes. Follow the instructions provided with the update carefully to avoid any issues.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your YSP-5600BL, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps. For more detailed solutions, consult the full user manual available online.

No Sound

- Ensure the sound bar is powered on and the correct input source is selected.
- Check volume levels on both the sound bar and your TV/source device.
- Verify all cables (HDMI, optical) are securely connected.
- If using HDMI ARC, ensure ARC is enabled on your TV and the sound bar.

Network/MusicCast Connectivity Issues

- Confirm your Wi-Fi router is functioning correctly and the sound bar is within range.
- Restart your router, the sound bar, and your control device (smartphone/tablet).
- Ensure the MusicCast app is updated to the latest version.

Remote Control Not Working

- Check and replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the sound bar's IR receiver.




