## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Donco Kids Beach Cabin Twin Rustic Sand House Loft Bed is designed to provide a unique and imaginative sleeping space. Crafted from solid pine wood with a non-toxic Rustic Sand Finish, this bed offers durability and meets or exceeds ASTM/CPSC standards. It accommodates any standard twin mattress and features a distinctive house-like structure.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

### Important Safety Guidelines:

- Ensure the bed frame supports a maximum weight of **160 pounds**. Exceeding this weight limit may compromise the structural integrity and safety of the bed.
- Regularly inspect all bolts and connections to ensure they are tight. Loose connections can lead to instability.
- Do not allow children to hang or swing from any part of the bed structure.
- Keep the area around the bed clear of obstacles to prevent falls.
- Always use the appropriate mattress size (Twin) to ensure a snug fit and prevent entrapment.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Donco Kids Twin Rustic Sand Low Loft Tree House Bed requires assembly. Your purchase includes all essential tools and hardware for setup. It is recommended to assemble the bed in the room where it will be used due to its size.

### Before You Begin:

- Read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- Identify all parts and hardware. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Ensure you have adequate space for assembly.
- Two adults are recommended for assembly to ensure safety and ease of construction.

### **Assembly Steps:**

1. Begin by assembling the main bed frame components (footboard, headboard, and side rails) according to the provided diagrams. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. Attach the roof and side panels to create the tree house structure. Note that the design allows for flexibility in window placement; you may choose to leave one side open for easier access if desired.
3. Install the wooden slats across the bed frame to support the mattress. Ensure they are evenly spaced and securely fastened.
4. Attach the ladder securely to the designated points on the bed frame. Verify that the ladder is stable before use.
5. Once fully assembled, double-check all screws and bolts to ensure they are tightened to prevent wobbling or instability.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This loft bed is designed for use with a standard twin-sized mattress. No box spring is required as the bed features a slatted base for mattress support.

- Place a twin mattress directly onto the wooden slats.
- Ensure the mattress fits snugly within the frame to prevent gaps.
- The integrated ladder provides access to the sleeping area. Always use the ladder for entry and exit.
- The open design of the bed allows for creative decoration and personalization, transforming it into a unique play and sleep space.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your Donco Kids bed.

- **Cleaning:** Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For spills, clean immediately with a damp cloth and mild soap, then wipe dry. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the Rustic Sand

Finish.

- **Inspection:** Periodically check all hardware (screws, bolts) and tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Environment:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources, which can cause wood to dry out, crack, or fade.
- **Moving:** When moving the bed, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent damage to the frame and your flooring.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues with your bed, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Wobbling or Instability:**
  - Ensure all assembly hardware (screws, bolts) are fully tightened. Over time, these can loosen.
  - Verify that the bed is placed on a flat, level surface. Uneven flooring can cause instability.

- **Squeaking Noises:**

- Tighten all connections, especially where the slats meet the side rails.
- Check if the mattress is properly seated on the slats.

- **Difficulty with Assembly:**

- Re-read the assembly instructions carefully, paying close attention to diagrams.
- Ensure all parts are correctly oriented before tightening.
- Confirm all included components are present. If parts are missing, contact customer support.
