# Daiwa Presso Ultralight Pack Spinning Rod PSO604ULFS-TR Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for the proper assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Daiwa Presso Ultralight Pack Spinning Rod, model PSO604ULFS-TR. This 6-foot, 4-piece rod is engineered for ultralight fishing techniques, offering a combination of casting power for light lures and shock-absorbing action for handling fish on ultra-fine lines. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your rod to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

## KEY FEATURES

---

- **IM-7 Graphite Construction:** Provides a lightweight yet strong blank for enhanced sensitivity and power.
- **Micro Pitch Blank Taping:** Ensures even distribution of resin and graphite during curing, contributing to maximum power and sensitivity.
- **Reel Seat with Machined Clamp Nut and Woven Graphite Insert:** Securely holds your spinning reel in place while offering a comfortable grip.
- **Minima Black Ring Guides:** Lightweight and durable guides designed for smooth line flow and reduced friction.
- **Lightweight Split Grip Cork Handles:** Offers a comfortable and sensitive grip, reducing fatigue during extended use.

### Rod Assembly

1. **Unpack the Rod:** Carefully remove all four rod sections from the travel case.
2. **Connect the Butt Section:** Take the butt section (the section with the handle and reel seat) and the next largest section. Align the guides and gently push the male ferrule of the second section into the female ferrule of the butt section. Twist slightly to ensure a snug fit.
3. **Connect Middle Sections:** Continue connecting the remaining sections in decreasing order of thickness, moving towards the tip. Always align the guides before pushing the ferrules together.
4. **Attach the Tip Section:** Connect the thinnest tip section last, ensuring all guides are perfectly aligned along the length of the rod.
5. **Check Connections:** Verify that all sections are securely seated and the guides are aligned. Do not force connections.

### Reel Attachment

1. **Position the Reel:** Place your spinning reel onto the reel seat, ensuring the reel foot is properly

seated.

2. **Secure the Reel:** Tighten the machined clamp nut on the reel seat until the reel is firmly secured and does not wobble. Do not overtighten.
3. **Thread the Line:** Open the bail of your spinning reel and thread the fishing line through all the rod guides, starting from the guide closest to the reel and ending at the tip guide. Close the bail.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The Daiwa Presso Ultralight Pack Spinning Rod is designed for precision and sensitivity, making it ideal for targeting smaller fish species with light tackle. Its fast action allows for quick hook sets and accurate casting of lightweight lures.

### Casting Techniques

- **Overhead Cast:** This is a fundamental casting technique. Hold the rod with your dominant hand, with your thumb on the line. Bring the rod back over your shoulder, then swiftly forward, releasing the line with your thumb as the rod reaches a 10 o'clock position.
- **Sidarm Cast:** Useful in areas with overhead obstructions. Perform a similar motion to the overhead cast, but keep the rod parallel to the ground.

## Target Species and Lures

This ultralight rod is particularly effective for species such as trout, perch, crappie, and small bass. It performs best with lightweight lures, including small spinners, spoons, jigs, and soft plastics. The sensitive tip allows you to detect subtle bites, while the rod's backbone provides sufficient power to manage these fish.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance will extend the life and performance of your Daiwa Presso rod.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, especially in saltwater environments, rinse the rod with fresh water to remove salt, dirt, and debris. Use a soft cloth to wipe down the blank, guides, and handle.
- **Drying:** Allow the rod to air dry completely before storing. Ensure no moisture is trapped between the rod sections or in the ferrules.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the rod guides for any cracks, bends, or loose inserts. Check the reel seat for secure attachment and the cork handle for any damage.
- **Storage:** Store the rod in its provided travel case or a rod sock to protect it from physical damage and environmental elements. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Ferrule Care:** Occasionally apply a small amount of ferrule wax to the male ferrules to ensure smooth assembly and prevent wear.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Rod Sections Sticking:** If rod sections become difficult to separate, try twisting gently while pulling. Avoid excessive force. Applying a small amount of ferrule wax can prevent this issue.
- **Guides Misaligned:** During assembly, ensure careful alignment of all guides. If they become misaligned during use, gently twist the affected sections to correct.
- **Line Tangling:** Ensure your reel is properly spooled with line. Overfilling the spool or using line that is too heavy for the rod can lead to tangles. Check for damaged guides that might snag the line.
- **Reduced Sensitivity:** Ensure your reel is securely attached and all rod sections are fully seated. Loose connections can dampen the rod's sensitivity.
