PetSpy M86-2 Dog Training Collar User Manual

Model: M86-2

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and effective use of your PetSpy M86-2 Dog Training Collar. Please read this guide thoroughly before operating the device to ensure proper setup, training techniques, and maintenance. This system is designed to assist in training up to two dogs with various stimulation modes.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Not for Aggressive Dogs:** Do not use this product on aggressive dogs. Consult a professional trainer for behavioral issues.
- **Supervision Required:** Always supervise your dog during training sessions. Never leave your dog unattended with the training collar on.
- **Collar Fit:** Ensure the collar fits properly. It should be snug enough for the contact points to touch the skin, but loose enough to allow two fingers to fit comfortably between the collar and your dog's neck.
- **Duration of Wear:** To prevent skin irritation, avoid leaving the collar on your dog for more than 4 hours a day. Reposition the collar every 1 to 2 hours.
- **Leash Attachment:** Do not attach a leash to the training collar. Use a separate, non-metallic collar for leash attachment.
- **Children:** Keep the training system and its components out of reach of children.
- **Water Safety:** While the collar receiver is waterproof, ensure the charging port is securely sealed before exposing it to water.

Remote Transmitter Functions:

TRAINING MODES AND BUTTONS

1. Charging Port

SETUP AND INITIAL USE

1. Charging the Devices

Before first use, fully charge the remote transmitter and both collar receivers. Connect the dual USB charger to a power source and plug it into the charging ports of the devices. The indicator lights will typically turn solid green or off when charging is complete.

2. Pairing the Remote and Collars

To ensure the remote communicates with the correct collar, follow the pairing instructions provided in the detailed user guide included in your package. This usually involves turning on the collar receiver and pressing a specific button on the remote within a short time frame to establish a connection for Dog A and Dog B.

3. Fitting the Collar

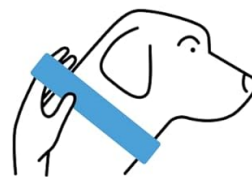
Use & Care Tips



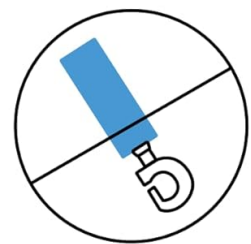
Don't keep the collar on your dog for over 4 hours a day



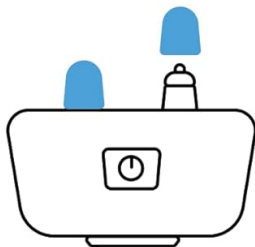
Use the collar only for short training sessions (10-15 min)



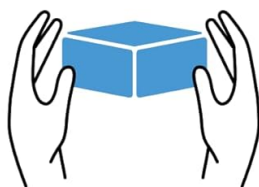
Make sure you can fit 2 fingers between the collar and the dog's neck



Don't attach a leash to the collar



Cover contact points with silicone caps



Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight



Check and clean the dog's neck daily



Clean the receiver with a damp cloth daily

This image illustrates essential use and care tips for the training collar, including proper fit and maintenance practices.

1. Ensure the collar is positioned correctly on your dog's neck, with the contact points touching the skin.
2. The fit should be snug enough for the contact points to make reliable contact, but not so tight as to restrict breathing or cause discomfort. You should be able to fit two fingers comfortably between the collar and your dog's neck.
3. Trim long fur if necessary to ensure proper contact between the probes and your dog's skin.
4. Select the appropriate length metal probes (short or long) based on your dog's coat type to ensure effective contact.

OPERATING THE TRAINING COLLAR

Training Modes:

- **Beep (Tone):** Delivers an audible tone. This mode is often used as a warning, an attention-getting signal, or a positive reinforcement marker.
- **Vibration:** Provides a non-harmful vibration. It can be used as a mild correction, a precursor to static stimulation, or a silent recall signal.
- **Static Shock:** Delivers a static stimulation. This mode should be used as a last resort for correcting undesirable behaviors and always at the lowest effective level.

Selecting a Dog (A/B Mode):

The remote transmitter allows you to switch between training Dog A and Dog B. Refer to the remote's display to confirm which dog is currently selected before issuing a command. This ensures you are communicating with the intended dog.

Adjusting Intensity Levels:

Both the vibration and static shock modes have adjustable intensity levels. Always start at the lowest level and gradually increase until your dog responds with a noticeable reaction, such as a head turn or ear twitch. The goal is to get your dog's attention and interrupt behavior, not to cause pain or fear.

Basic Training Principles:

Use the collar to interrupt undesirable behaviors or reinforce commands. Always follow a correction with praise or a reward when your dog performs the desired action. Short, frequent training sessions are more effective than long, infrequent ones.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly clean the collar receiver and the dog's neck area to prevent skin irritation. Use a damp cloth for the receiver and ensure it is dry before charging.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a dry place, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and corrosive materials.
- **Contact Points:** Periodically check the contact points for wear and ensure they are clean. Cover contact points with the provided silicone caps when not in use or if your dog has sensitive skin to minimize direct contact.
- **Battery Life:** Recharge the devices when the battery indicator shows low power to ensure consistent performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Collar not responding to remote	Low battery on either device; Collar not paired; Out of range; Radio interference	Charge both remote and collar receivers; Re-pair the collar and remote according to instructions; Move closer to your dog; Avoid areas with strong electromagnetic fields.
No static stimulation	Poor contact with skin; Contact points too short for dog's fur; Static level too low; Test bulb not working	Adjust collar fit to ensure contact; Use longer contact points if your dog has thick fur; Increase static level gradually; Test the static function with the included test bulb.
Skin irritation on dog's neck	Collar worn for too long; Improper fit (too tight or too loose); Dirty contact points or neck area	Limit wear time to a maximum of 4 hours per day and reposition frequently; Adjust collar for proper fit; Clean collar and dog's neck daily. Consult a veterinarian if irritation persists.
Remote display not working	Low battery; Device damage	Charge the remote transmitter; If damaged, contact customer support for assistance.








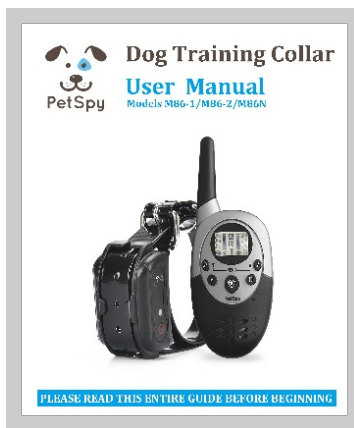

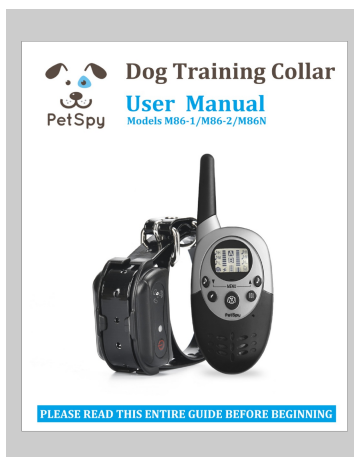
