1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing Soundix. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Soundix product. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

3. SETUP

Follow these steps for initial setup of your Soundix device:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all items listed in the package contents are present.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power adapter to the device's power input port. Plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
3. **Initial Power On:** Press and hold the power button (usually located on the top or side) for 3 seconds until the indicator light illuminates.
4. **Pairing (if applicable):** If your Soundix device requires pairing with another device (e.g., smartphone, computer), activate Bluetooth on the external device and select "Soundix" from the list of available

devices. Refer to your external device's manual for specific pairing instructions.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

No sound output.	Volume too low, incorrect mode, or device not paired.	Increase volume, select the correct input mode, or re-pair the device.
Bluetooth connection unstable.	Distance too far, interference, or low battery.	Move devices closer, avoid obstacles, or charge the device.
