#### INTRODUCTION

The CHACON 54008 Mechanical Outdoor Timer is designed to automate the operation of your electrical devices, particularly suitable for outdoor use due to its IP44 protection rating. This timer allows you to program specific on/off cycles, assisting in efficient power management. It features up to 48 on/off cycles per day, with a minimum interval of 15 minutes per cycle.

# **Key Features:**

- Up to 48 programmable on/off cycles daily.
- Minimum 15-minute switching interval.
- IP44 protection against humidity and splashing water, suitable for outdoor use.
- Maximum power capacity of 3500W.

# **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

## SETUP AND INITIAL CONFIGURATION

- 1. **Set Current Time:** Rotate the entire time dial clockwise until the current time aligns with the arrow indicator on the timer's face. The dial is marked from 1 to 24 hours.
- 2. Program ON/OFF Cycles:

- Each small segment around the dial represents 15 minutes.
- To set a period when the device should beON, push the corresponding segments downwards.
- To set a period when the device should beOFF, leave the corresponding segments in the upwards position.
- You can program up to 48 ON/OFF cycles within a 24-hour period.
- 3. **Connect to Power:** Plug the CHACON 54008 timer into a suitable wall socket. Ensure the socket is compatible with the timer's plug type (e.g., Type E/F).
- 4. **Connect Device:** Plug the electrical device you wish to control into the output socket of the timer. Ensure the device's power consumption does not exceed 3500W.
- 5. Select Operating Mode: Use the manual override switch on the side to select the desired mode:
  - Timer Mode (Clock Icon): The timer will operate according to your programmed ON/OFF cycles.
  - Always ON (I): The connected device will remain continuously on, bypassing the timer settings.
  - Always OFF (O): The connected device will remain continuously off, bypassing the timer settings.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Once the timer is set up and the operating mode is selected to 'Timer Mode', it will automatically switch your connected device on and off according to your programmed schedule. The internal mechanism will continuously rotate the time dial, activating the switch when a depressed segment passes the indicator.

- Monitoring: Periodically check the timer to ensure it is functioning as expected, especially after power outages, as mechanical timers do not retain time during power loss.
- Adjusting Programs: To change the ON/OFF schedule, simply push the segments up or down as required.
- **Manual Override:** Use the side switch to temporarily turn the device ON or OFF without altering the programmed schedule. Remember to switch it back to 'Timer Mode' for automatic operation.

### **M**AINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Disconnect the timer from the power outlet before cleaning. Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the timer in water.
- Environmental Protection: The timer has an IP44 rating, meaning it is protected against solid objects larger than 1mm and against splashing water from any direction. While suitable for outdoor use, avoid direct exposure to heavy rain or submersion.
- **Storage:** If storing the timer for an extended period, ensure it is clean and dry. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Device does not turn ON/OFF as programmed.	<ul> <li>Manual override switch is not in 'Timer Mode'.</li> <li>Segments are not correctly depressed/raised.</li> <li>Current time is not set correctly.</li> <li>Power outage.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure the switch is set to the clock icon.</li> <li>Verify all segments are correctly positioned for desired ON/OFF times.</li> <li>Reset the current time on the dial.</li> <li>Reset the current time after power is restored.</li> </ul>
Timer does not fit into wall socket.	Incompatible plug type.	The CHACON 54008 typically uses a Type E/F (Schuko) plug. Ensure your wall socket is compatible. Do not force the plug. Consult an electrician if unsure.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device connected to timer is not working.	<ul> <li>Device itself is faulty.</li> <li>Timer is not receiving power.</li> <li>Device exceeds timer's maximum power rating.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Test the device by plugging it directly into a wall socket.</li> <li>Check the wall socket with another appliance.</li> <li>Ensure the connected device's power consumption is below 3500W.</li> </ul>


