1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Yaheetech Wrought Iron Bird Cage. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all parts are securely fastened before placing birds inside the cage.
- Regularly inspect the cage for any damaged or loose components that could pose a risk to your pets.
- Keep small children and pets away during assembly to prevent injury or ingestion of small parts.
- Position the cage on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not overload the cage with excessive accessories or birds beyond its recommended capacity.

3. PARTS LIST

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

- 3. Construct the Cage Base:** Place the bottom cage panel onto the assembled stand. Insert the slide-out tray and mesh grate.
- 4. Attach Side Panels:** Connect the front, back, and side panels of the cage, ensuring all latches and connectors are aligned and secured.
- 5. Install Interior Accessories:** Insert the main wooden perches and any included toys or ladders.
- 6. Assemble Playtop:** Attach the playtop assembly, including the additional perch, ladder, and feeding bowls, to the top of the cage.
- 7. Final Inspection:** Double-check all connections and ensure the cage is stable and secure before introducing any birds.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Accessing the Cage

The cage features a large front door for easy access. To open, unlatch the button lock mechanism. Ensure the door is securely closed and latched after placing or removing birds.

5.2 Feeding and Watering

The cage is equipped with arched wire feeding doors for convenient refilling of seeds and water. Two stainless steel feeding bowls are provided for the main cage interior, and two additional bowls are located on the playtop.

5.3 Using the Playtop

The playtop area provides an additional space for your birds to stand, stretch, and interact outside the main cage. It includes a ladder, a wooden dowel perch, and two feeding bowls. Ensure birds are supervised when utilizing the playtop.

5.4 Mobility

The cage is equipped with four 360-degree ball casters for easy movement. To relocate the cage, gently push it to the desired position. Ensure the casters are locked if stationary positioning is required (if applicable, check caster design).




Image 5.4: Illustration of the cage's mobility, highlighting the convenience of its 360-degree rolling casters for effortless repositioning.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Cage

Regular cleaning is essential for maintaining a hygienic environment for your birds. The cage is designed with convenient features to facilitate cleaning:

- **Slide-out Tray:** The bottom slide-out tray can be easily removed for waste disposal and cleaning.
- **Detachable Mesh Grate:** A mesh grate separates the birds from their droppings, preventing direct contact. This grate is also detachable for thorough cleaning.
- **Water-Resistant Paint:** The powder-coated steel construction with water-resistant paint allows for easy wiping and cleaning of surfaces.

6.2 General Care

- Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight.
- Replace worn or damaged perches and toys as needed.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could harm your birds or damage the cage finish. Use mild soap and water.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bird cage.

- **Issue: Cage feels unstable after assembly.**
Solution: Ensure all screws and bolts are tightened securely. Verify the cage is placed on a flat, level surface. Check that the casters are properly installed and locked if intended to be stationary.
- **Issue: Doors do not close properly.**
Solution: Inspect the door hinges and latches for any obstructions or misalignment. Gently adjust the door frame if necessary to ensure a snug fit and secure latching.
- **Issue: Difficulty moving the cage.**
Solution: Check if the caster wheels are locked. Ensure the wheels are free of debris that might impede movement. Clean and lubricate the casters if necessary.


