1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Yale YH Collection Pacific Beach Privacy Lever. This polished brass privacy lever is designed for interior doors where privacy is desired, such as bedrooms or bathrooms. The latch bolt is operated by either the inside or outside lever. The inside lever can be locked by a push button. The push button is released by a special emergency release tool from the outside or by turning the inside lever.

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning installation to ensure correct and safe operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves and eye protection, during installation.
- Use only the tools specified in the installation instructions.
- Keep small parts and tools out of reach of children.
- Ensure the door is properly prepared and stable before installing the lever.
- Do not force components during installation; if parts do not fit, re-read the instructions or consult support.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- Exterior Lever Assembly (with spindle)
- Interior Lever Assembly (with push button)
- Latch Mechanism
- Mounting Screws
- Strike Plate
- Dust Box
- Emergency Release Tool

4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Yale YH Collection Pacific Beach Privacy Lever features an easy install mounting system with concealed mounting screws for a clean, upgraded look.

Tools Required:

- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Measuring Tape
- Pencil

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Door:** Ensure your door has standard bore holes (typically 2-1/8 inch diameter for the cross bore and 1 inch diameter for the edge bore). Measure the backset (distance from the door edge to the center of the cross bore) to confirm it is either 2-3/8 inches or 2-3/4 inches. Adjust the latch if necessary.
2. **Install the Latch:** Insert the latch mechanism into the edge bore hole of the door, ensuring the bevel

of the latch bolt faces the door frame. Secure it with the provided screws.

3. **Install the Exterior Lever:** Insert the exterior lever assembly through the cross bore hole, ensuring the spindle passes through the latch mechanism.
4. **Install the Interior Lever:** Place the interior lever assembly onto the spindle and align it with the mounting posts from the exterior assembly. Secure the interior and exterior assemblies together using the provided mounting screws. Tighten screws evenly until snug, but do not overtighten.
5. **Install the Strike Plate:** Close the door and mark the position of the latch bolt on the door frame. Chisel out a shallow recess for the strike plate and dust box. Install the dust box, then secure the strike plate with screws.
6. **Test Operation:** Test the lever's functionality as described in the Operating Instructions section.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Yale YH Collection Pacific Beach Privacy Lever is designed for simple and reliable privacy control.

- **To Open from Either Side:** Turn the lever handle downwards. The latch bolt will retract, allowing the door to open.
- **To Lock from the Inside:** Locate the push button on the interior lever assembly. Press the button to engage the privacy lock. The exterior lever will now be disengaged, preventing entry.
- **To Unlock from the Inside:** Simply turn the interior lever handle downwards. This action will automatically release the push button and unlock the door.
- **Emergency Unlock from the Outside:** In case of an emergency or accidental lockout, insert the provided emergency release tool (or a small, pointed object like a paperclip) into the small hole on the center of the exterior lever's rosette. Push firmly to disengage the privacy lock.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your Yale Pacific Beach Privacy Lever.

- **Cleaning:** To maintain the polished brass finish, clean regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- **Lubrication:** If the lever action becomes stiff over time, a small amount of graphite lubricant can be applied to the latch bolt mechanism. Do not use oil-based lubricants, as they can attract dust and grime.
- **Screw Tightness:** Periodically check and tighten all mounting screws to ensure the lever remains securely attached to the door. Do not overtighten.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your privacy lever, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lever does not turn or is stiff.	Misalignment of components; debris in mechanism; overtightened screws.	Check for obstructions. Loosen and re-tighten mounting screws. Apply graphite lubricant to latch.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Latch bolt does not retract fully.	Latch mechanism not installed correctly; strike plate misalignment.	Verify correct installation of the latch mechanism. Adjust strike plate position.
Privacy button does not engage/disengage.	Internal mechanism issue; debris.	Ensure the lever is installed correctly. If issue persists, contact customer support.
Door rattles when closed.	Strike plate not properly aligned or recessed.	Adjust the strike plate to ensure a snug fit with the latch bolt.
