# Blue Bird 65134 Trimmer Kawasaki TJ53E User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Blue Bird 65134 Trimmer with Kawasaki TJ53E engine. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the machine to ensure proper use and to prevent injury or damage.

## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always prioritize safety when operating power tools. Adhere to the following guidelines:

- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including eye protection, hearing protection, gloves, and sturdy footwear.
- Ensure the work area is clear of bystanders, pets, and debris.

- Do not operate the trimmer in wet conditions or near flammable materials.
- Inspect the trimmer for any damage or loose parts before each use.
- Familiarize yourself with the controls and emergency shut-off procedures.

## SETUP

---

### Assembly

The Blue Bird 65134 Trimmer may require some assembly out of the box. Follow these steps:

1. Carefully unpack all components and verify against the packing list.
2. Attach the handle to the shaft, ensuring it is securely fastened at a comfortable operating position.
3. Mount the safety guard over the cutting head, ensuring it is firmly in place to protect against debris.
4. Connect the cutting head (trimmer line or blade) according to the specific instructions provided with the cutting attachment.
5. Ensure all bolts and fasteners are tightened before use.

### Fuel Mixture

This gas-powered trimmer requires a specific fuel mixture. Refer to the Kawasaki TJ53E engine manual for the exact fuel-to-oil ratio. Typically, a 2-stroke engine requires a mixture of unleaded gasoline and high-quality 2-stroke engine oil. Mix the fuel in a separate, approved container before adding it to the trimmer's fuel tank.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Starting the Engine

1. Place the trimmer on a flat, stable surface.
2. Ensure the ignition switch is in the "ON" position.
3. Engage the choke (if cold starting).
4. Press the primer bulb several times until fuel is visible.
5. Pull the starter cord firmly and smoothly until the engine fires.
6. Once the engine starts, gradually disengage the choke.
7. Allow the engine to warm up for a few moments before engaging the throttle.

### Trimming Operation

Hold the trimmer firmly with both hands. Maintain a balanced stance. Use a sweeping motion to cut grass and weeds. Avoid hitting hard objects like rocks, fences, or concrete, as this can damage the cutting head or cause kickback.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your trimmer.

- **Air Filter:** Clean the air filter regularly, especially in dusty conditions. Replace if damaged.
- **Spark Plug:** Inspect and clean the spark plug periodically. Replace if worn or fouled.
- **Fuel Filter:** Check and replace the fuel filter as needed to prevent fuel system issues.
- **Gearbox Lubrication:** Ensure the gearbox is adequately lubricated. Refer to the engine manual for

recommended lubricant type and frequency.

- **Cutting Head:** Inspect the trimmer line or blade for wear and replace as necessary.
- **General Cleaning:** Keep the trimmer clean from grass clippings and debris.

### Storage

Before storing the trimmer for an extended period, drain the fuel tank or use a fuel stabilizer. Clean the unit thoroughly and store it in a dry, secure location away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine does not start	No fuel, clogged fuel filter, fouled spark plug, ignition switch OFF, incorrect choke setting.	Check fuel level, clean/replace fuel filter, clean/replace spark plug, turn ignition ON, adjust choke.
Engine runs poorly	Dirty air filter, incorrect fuel mixture, worn spark plug, carburetor issues.	Clean air filter, use correct fuel mixture, replace spark plug, consult service professional for carburetor.
Excessive vibration	Damaged cutting head, loose components.	Inspect and replace cutting head if damaged, tighten all fasteners.







