The Miele Steam Oven Descaler Tablets are designed for convenient and effective descaling. Each pack contains 12 tablets, typically provided in two blister packs of six tablets each.

USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Preparation:** Ensure your Miele appliance is turned off and cooled down. Empty any water reservoirs or drip trays as instructed by your appliance.

MAINTENANCE AND FREQUENCY

For Miele coffee machines, it is generally recommended to descale every 500-1000 cups of coffee, or as indicated by your appliance's descaling reminder. For steam ovens, follow the descaling prompts on the appliance's display. The frequency may vary depending on the hardness of your local water supply and the intensity of appliance use. Consistent descaling prevents limescale buildup, which can impair heating efficiency, reduce water flow, and potentially damage internal components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during or after the descaling process, consider the following:

- **Descaling Reminder Persists:** Ensure all rinsing cycles have been completed as per your appliance's instructions. Sometimes, a second rinse cycle is necessary.
- **Appliance Not Functioning Correctly After Descaling:** Verify that the water reservoir is properly seated and filled with fresh water. Check for any error messages on the appliance display and consult your appliance's specific manual for error code interpretations.
- **Incomplete Descaling:** If significant limescale buildup was present, a single descaling cycle might not be sufficient. You may need to repeat the descaling process.
- **Tablet Not Dissolving:** Ensure the water used is lukewarm and stir gently to aid dissolution. Do not force dissolution or use hot water unless specified by your appliance manual.


