Yamato "Noppo" Wastebasket Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Product Overview

The Yamato "Noppo" Wastebasket (Model YK08-106) is a stylish and functional 20-liter capacity waste receptacle designed for home and office use. Crafted from high-quality Cena plywood and MDF with a lacquer finish, its sleek, rectangular design and brown color blend seamlessly into various interior decors. This lidless wastebasket offers convenient disposal and is ideal for kitchens, living rooms, or offices.

1.2 Package Contents

- 1 x Yamato "Noppo" Wastebasket (Main Unit)
- 1 x Removable Wooden Top Panel

2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect the wastebasket and its wooden top panel for any signs of damage during transit. Retain packaging materials for future transport or storage if necessary.

2.2 Assembly and Placement

The Yamato "Noppo" Wastebasket comes pre-assembled. Simply place the removable wooden top panel into the designated slot at the top of the wastebasket. Choose a flat, stable surface for placement, such as a kitchen corner, office desk side, or living room area. Ensure adequate space around the unit for easy access and waste disposal.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

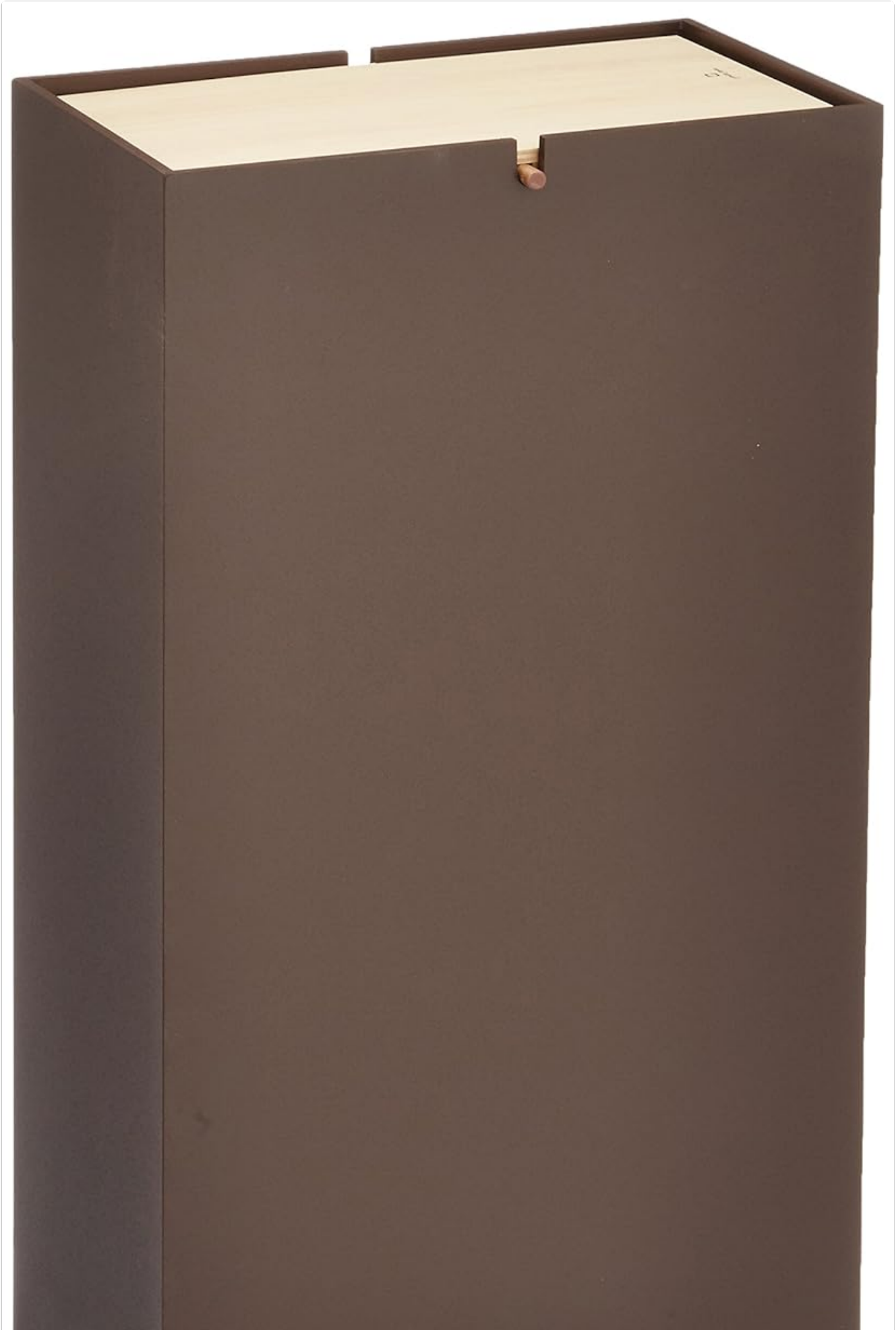
3.1 Waste Disposal

To dispose of waste, simply lift the wooden top panel or slide it to the side to access the opening. The wastebasket is designed for general household or office waste. For optimal hygiene and to prevent odors, it is recommended to use a standard trash bag (approximately 20-liter capacity) inside the wastebasket.

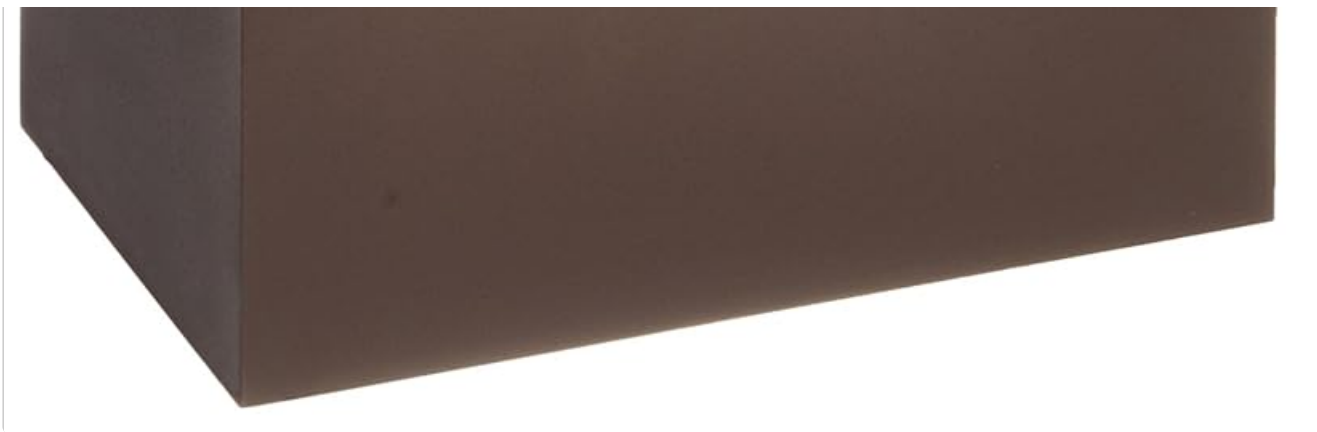


Figure 3.1.2: Angled view of the wastebasket.

3.2 Removing Waste

When the wastebasket is full, lift the wooden top panel. If a trash bag is used, tie the top of the bag securely and lift it out of the wastebasket. Replace with a new trash bag as needed. Re-position the wooden top panel after emptying.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

To clean the exterior of the wastebasket, wipe it with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, a mild, non-abrasive cleaner can be used, followed by wiping with a clean, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the lacquer finish.

The interior can be wiped clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Ensure the interior is completely dry before placing a new trash bag or resuming use.

4.2 Care and Storage

To prolong the life of your wastebasket, avoid exposing it to excessive moisture or direct sunlight for extended periods. Store in a dry environment when not in use.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Common Issues

- **Odors:** Ensure a trash bag is used and changed regularly. Clean the interior thoroughly if odors persist.
- **Scratches/Dents:** Handle the wastebasket with care to prevent surface damage. Minor scratches on the lacquer finish may be repairable with furniture polish designed for lacquered surfaces.
- **Wooden Panel Sticking:** Ensure the wooden panel and its slot are clean and free of debris.

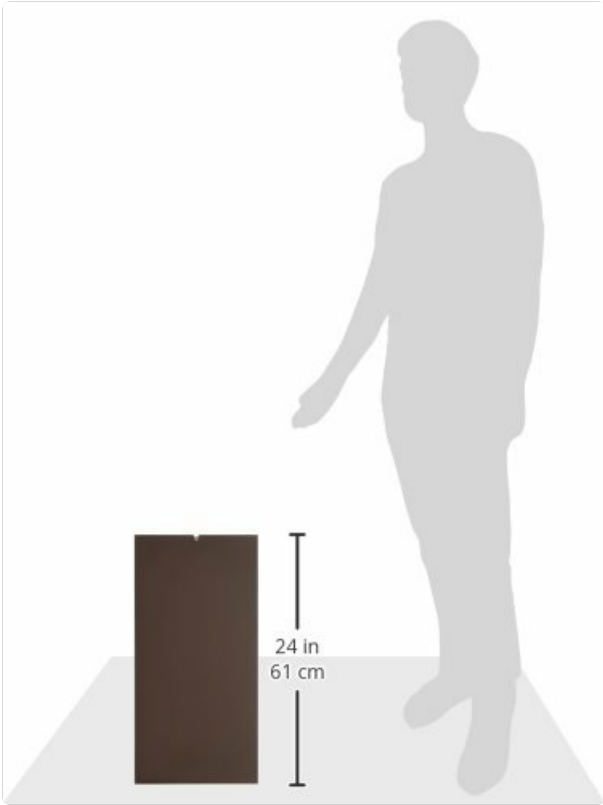


Figure 6.1.1: Product dimensions diagram.
