1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Sansui 122 cm (48 Inches) Full HD LED TV, model SKY48FB11FA. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your television. Please read it thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, please observe the following precautions:

- Do not expose the TV to rain or moisture to prevent fire or electric shock.
- Do not block ventilation openings. Ensure adequate space around the TV for proper airflow.
- Avoid placing the TV on unstable surfaces.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched.
- Unplug the TV during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

3. WHAT'S IN THE Box

Carefully unpack your Sansui TV and check that all the following items are included:

- 1 x Sansui LED TV
- 1 x User Manual (this document)
- 1 x Warranty Card
- 1 x Remote Control
- 1 x Power Cable / Power Supply Adapter

4. SETUP

4.1 Physical Installation

Your Sansui TV can be installed on a stand or wall-mounted. For wall mounting, ensure you use a compatible VESA mount (not included) and follow the instructions provided with the wall mount kit. For professional installation or wall mounting, please contact Sansui support at 18004194040.

4.2 Connecting Peripherals

Connect your external devices to the TV using the appropriate ports:

- **HDMI (x4):** For high-definition audio and video from Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, set-top boxes, etc.
- **USB (x2):** For connecting USB storage devices to play media files.
- **VGA (x1):** For connecting a computer.
- **Component (x1):** For connecting older video devices using YPbPr cables.

4.3 Power Connection

After connecting all necessary peripherals, plug the power cable into the TV's power input and then into a wall outlet. The TV will enter standby mode.

5. OPERATING

5.1 Power On/Off

Press the Power button on the remote control or on the TV to turn the TV on or off (standby mode).

5.2 Input Source Selection

Press the 'Source' or 'Input' button on your remote control to cycle through available input sources (HDMI 1, HDMI 2, USB, VGA, Component, TV Tuner). Select the desired input for your connected device.

5.3 Basic Remote Control Functions

- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjusts the sound level.
- **Channel Up/Down:** Changes TV channels.
- **Mute:** Silences the TV audio.
- **Menu:** Accesses the TV's main settings menu.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Navigate through menus.
- **OK/Enter:** Confirms selections.
- **Exit/Back:** Returns to the previous screen or exits the menu.

5.4 Picture and Sound Settings

Access the 'Menu' to adjust picture settings (e.g., Brightness, Contrast, Color, Picture Mode) and sound settings (e.g., Bass, Treble, Sound Mode, Balance) to your preference.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your TV:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, use a screen cleaner specifically designed for TVs, applied to the cloth, not directly to the screen.
- **Cleaning the Cabinet:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the TV cabinet. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation openings on the back of the TV are not blocked to prevent overheating.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No power	Check if the power cable is securely plugged into the TV and the wall outlet. Ensure the wall outlet is functioning.
No picture, but sound is present	Verify the correct input source is selected. Check cable connections to external devices.
No sound, but picture is present	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. Verify audio cable connections for external devices.
Remote control not working	Replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
Poor picture quality	Adjust picture settings in the menu. Check the quality of the input signal or source device.
