Spectracide Weed Stop For Lawns2 Refill Instruction Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Spectracide Weed Stop For Lawns2 is a selective herbicide designed to control over 200 types of broadleaf weeds in lawns without harming the grass when used as directed. This product is a refill intended for use with the Spectracide AccuShot continuous power sprayer (sold separately). It provides visible results within hours and is rainfast in 6 hours, ensuring effectiveness even after light rain.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always read and follow all label directions and precautions before using this product. Keep out of reach of children and pets. Avoid ingestion. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as gloves and eye protection, during handling and application. Do not apply near water sources or in a manner that could contaminate water.

- Wear protective gloves and eye protection during application.
- Do not apply to desirable plants or crops.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and heat.

3. SETUP AND PREPARATION

This product is a refill for the Spectracide AccuShot continuous power sprayer. Ensure you have the AccuShot sprayer unit before proceeding with setup.

3.1 Attaching to AccuShot Sprayer

1. Remove the cap from the Spectracide Weed Stop For Lawns2 refill bottle.
2. Carefully align the AccuShot sprayer hose connector with the opening of the refill bottle.
3. Twist the connector clockwise until it is securely fastened to prevent leaks.
4. Ensure the sprayer is primed according to the AccuShot sprayer instructions before first use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Application Guidelines

For optimal results, apply Spectracide Weed Stop For Lawns2 when weeds are actively growing. Follow these steps for effective application:

- **Timing:** Apply when daytime temperatures are between 60°F and 85°F (15°C and 29°C). Do not apply when temperatures are above 85°F, as lawn injury may occur.
- **Coverage:** Spray just enough product to lightly cover the weeds. Avoid over-saturating the lawn.

- **Rainfastness:** The product is rainfast in 6 hours, meaning it will not wash off after this period.
- **Re-treatment:** Some hard-to-kill weeds may require re-treatment. Wait at least 30 days between applications.

4.2 Target Weeds

Spectracide Weed Stop For Lawns2 effectively controls over 200 types of broadleaf weeds, including but not limited to:

- Dandelion
- Chickweed
- Clover
- Poison Ivy
- Poison Oak
- Blackberry
- Kudzu




Image 4: Three circular insets show close-up images of common weeds: dandelion, chickweed, and clover, indicating the product's effectiveness against these types.

5. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

5.1 Product Storage

Store the Spectracide Weed Stop For Lawns2 refill in its original container, tightly closed, in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing and excessive heat.

5.2 Sprayer Maintenance

After each use, disconnect the refill bottle from the AccuShot sprayer. Rinse the sprayer nozzle and hose with water according to the AccuShot sprayer's instructions to prevent clogging and ensure proper function for future applications.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Weeds not dying:**

Ensure the product was applied during optimal temperature ranges (60-85°F). Verify that the weeds were lightly covered. Some tough weeds may require a second application after 30 days.

- **Lawn damage:**

Avoid applying when temperatures exceed 85°F. Do not over-apply the product; a light covering is sufficient. Ensure the product is used on established lawns and not on newly seeded areas or sensitive grass types not listed on the label.

- **Sprayer not working:**

Refer to the AccuShot continuous power sprayer's instruction manual for troubleshooting sprayer-specific issues, such as battery replacement or nozzle clogs.


