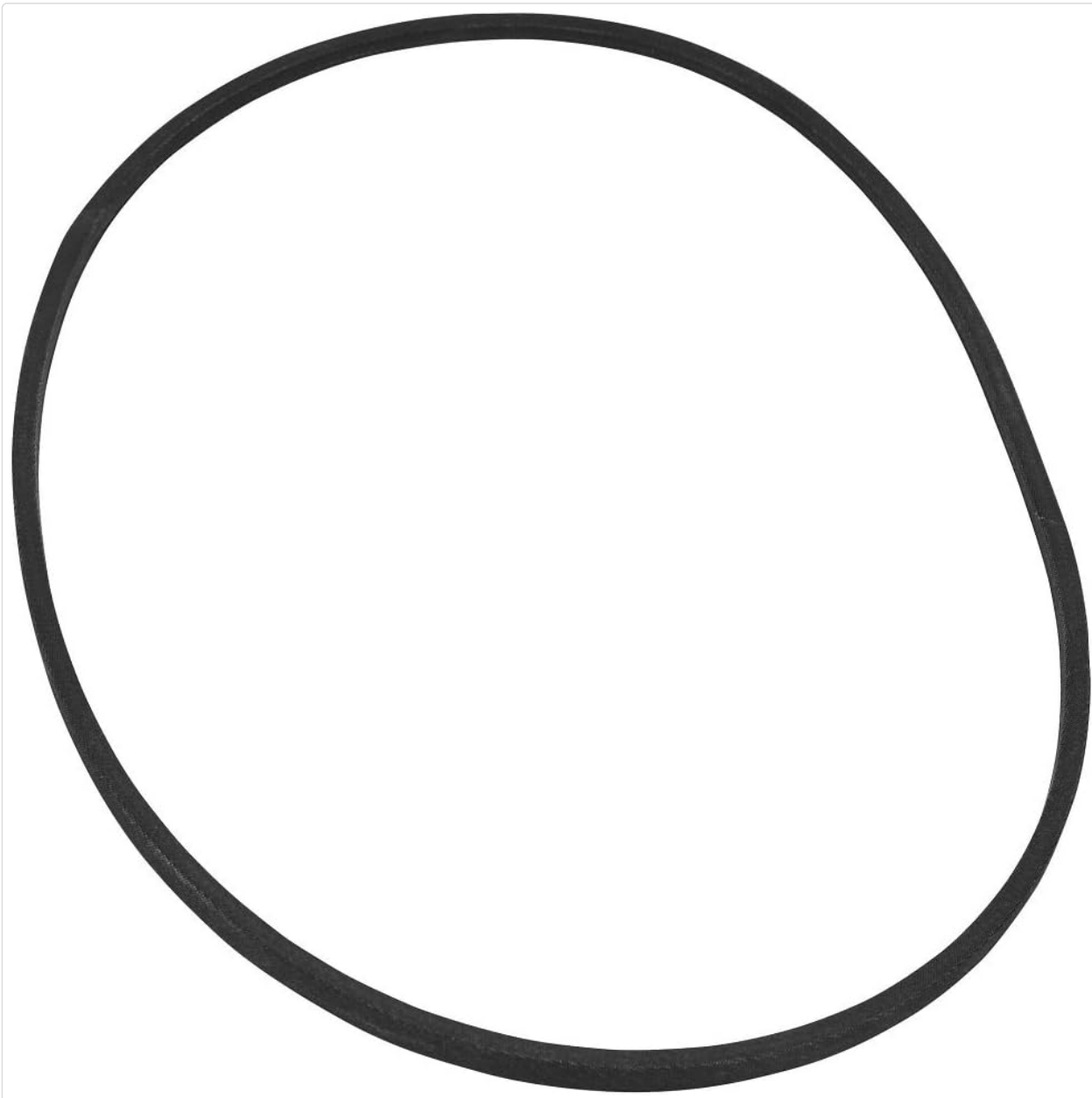


Figure 1: Husqvarna 539110411 Hydro Pump Belt






