# INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your GeneralAire Genuine OEM Replacement Humidifier Vapor Pad, model GA-23. Regular replacement of the humidifier vapor pad is crucial for maintaining efficient humidification and air quality in your home or building. Please read these instructions thoroughly before proceeding with installation or maintenance.

# PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GeneralAire GA-23 Vapor Pad is a critical component of your bypass or fan-powered humidifier. It is designed to absorb water and provide a large surface area for evaporation, allowing the humidifier to add moisture to the air circulated through your HVAC system.

# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Before beginning installation, ensure your humidifier and HVAC system are turned off at the thermostat and the main power supply.

- 1. **Turn off Power:** Locate the circuit breaker for your furnace/humidifier and switch it to the OFF position. Turn off the water supply valve to the humidifier.
- 2. **Access Humidifier:** Open the humidifier cover or access panel. This may involve releasing latches or removing screws, depending on your specific humidifier model.
- 3. **Remove Old Vapor Pad:** Carefully slide out the old vapor pad and its frame (if applicable). Dispose of the old pad responsibly.
- 4. Clean Humidifier: While the pad is removed, it is recommended to clean the humidifier's water distribution tray and drain pan to remove any mineral deposits or debris. Use a mild detergent and water, then rinse thoroughly.
- 5. **Install New Vapor Pad:** Insert the new GeneralAire GA-23 Vapor Pad into the humidifier, ensuring it is correctly oriented according to your humidifier's design. The pad should fit snugly within its holder.
- 6. Reassemble: Close and secure the humidifier cover or access panel.
- 7. **Restore Power and Water:** Turn the water supply valve back on. Restore power to the furnace/humidifier at the circuit breaker.
- 8. **Test Operation:** Set your thermostat to call for heat and humidity (if applicable) to verify proper operation of the humidifier and the new vapor pad. Check for any leaks.

**Note:** Some users have reported slight variations in pad dimensions. Ensure the pad is properly seated to prevent water bypass. If the pad seems slightly short, ensure careful side-to-side alignment within the holder.

# **OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE**

# **Operation**

The GA-23 Vapor Pad operates passively within your humidifier. Once installed, water flows over the pad, and the furnace fan circulates air through the moistened pad, adding humidity to your home's air. The humidifier's humidistat controls when the unit operates to maintain your desired humidity level.

# **Maintenance (Pad Replacement)**

The vapor pad should be replaced at least once per heating season, or more frequently in areas with hard water or heavy humidifier usage. Signs that a pad needs replacement include:

- · Reduced humidification output.
- Visible mineral buildup or discoloration on the pad.
- · Unpleasant odors from the humidifier.

Refer to the "Installation Instructions" section for detailed steps on replacing the vapor pad.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Humidity Output	Old, clogged, or improperly installed vapor pad.	Replace the vapor pad. Ensure correct installation and water flow.
Water Leaking	Vapor pad not seated correctly.	Re-seat the vapor pad, ensuring it is fully within its frame and aligned. Check water lines for secure connections.
Unpleasant Odor	Mineral buildup or mold on the vapor pad or within the humidifier.	Replace the vapor pad and thoroughly clean the humidifier's internal components.

If issues persist after following these steps, consult your humidifier's main instruction manual or contact a qualified HVAC technician.
