PRODUCT OVERVIEW




Figure 1: Maico G4 Replacement Air Filters (Set of 2)

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Maico G4 air filters are designed for tool-free replacement in compatible ventilation units. Follow these general steps for installation:

- 1. Power Off:** Before beginning, ensure the central ventilation unit (WR 310, WR 410, WS320, or WS 470) is completely powered off and disconnected from the main power supply to prevent accidental startup.
- 2. Locate Filter Compartment:** Refer to your ventilation unit's specific manual to locate the air filter compartment. This is typically accessible via a latch or cover.
- 3. Remove Old Filters:** Carefully open the compartment and remove the old, used air filters. Note their orientation to ensure correct installation of the new filters. Dispose of old filters responsibly.
- 4. Insert New Filters:** Insert the new Maico G4 replacement filters into the compartment, ensuring they are correctly oriented and seated firmly. The pleated side should face the direction of airflow as indicated in your unit's manual.
- 5. Close Compartment:** Securely close the filter compartment cover.
- 6. Restore Power:** Reconnect the ventilation unit to the power supply and turn it on.

Always consult your specific ventilation unit's instruction manual for detailed, model-specific filter replacement procedures.

OPERATION

Once installed, the Maico G4 air filter operates passively as part of your central ventilation system. Its primary function is to filter incoming air, removing dust, pollen, and other airborne particles to ensure clean and fresh air circulation within your environment.

No direct user interaction is required for the filter's operation beyond its proper installation and timely replacement.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your air filters is crucial for maintaining optimal air quality and the efficiency of your ventilation system. The Maico G4 filters are designed for replacement, not cleaning.

- Replacement Frequency:** The frequency of filter replacement depends on factors such as air quality in your area, usage of the ventilation system, and the presence of pets or allergens. As a general guideline, it is recommended to inspect filters every 3-6 months and replace them as needed.
- Signs of a Clogged Filter:**
 - Reduced airflow from vents.
 - Increased energy consumption of the ventilation unit.
 - Noticeable dust accumulation around vents or on surfaces.
 - Unpleasant odors.
- Disposal:** Dispose of used filters according to local waste disposal regulations.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues related to air filtration can be resolved by ensuring proper filter installation and timely replacement.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Airflow	Clogged filter; Incorrect filter installation.	Replace the filter; Ensure filter is correctly seated and oriented.
Dusty Environment	Filter needs replacement; Filter not sealing properly.	Replace the filter; Check filter compartment for proper closure and seal.
Unusual Odors	Filter is saturated with contaminants.	Replace the filter immediately.

If problems persist after following these steps, consult the manual for your specific ventilation unit or contact a qualified technician.
