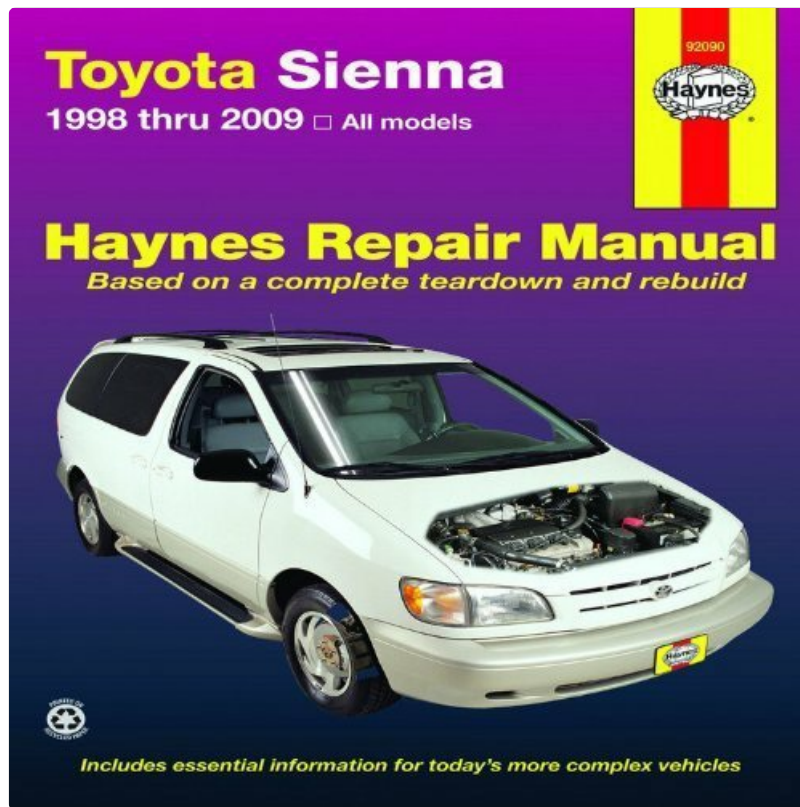

- **Every 30,000 miles / 24 months:** Spark plug inspection/replacement, fuel filter replacement, transmission fluid inspection.

Symptom	Possible Cause	Suggested Action
Engine cranks but won't start	Dead battery, faulty starter, fuel delivery issue, ignition system problem.	Check battery charge, inspect starter connections, verify fuel pressure, check spark.
Brakes squeal or grind	Worn brake pads, contaminated pads/rotors, seized caliper.	Inspect brake pads for wear, clean components, check caliper function.
Overheating engine	Low coolant, faulty thermostat, clogged radiator, failing water pump.	Check coolant level, test thermostat, inspect radiator for blockages, check water pump for leaks/noise.
