3. SETUP GUIDE

- Connect the Mouse:** Plug the USB connector of the Bloody A60L mouse into an available USB port on your computer.
- Driver Installation:** Your operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. If not, or for advanced customization, proceed to the next step.
- Install Bloody7 Software:** For full functionality and customization, download and install the Bloody7 software from the official Bloody website. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
- Software Configuration:** Launch the Bloody7 software to configure DPI settings, program buttons, and create macros according to your preferences.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Mouse Functions

- **Left Click:** Primary action, typically for selection or activation.
- **Right Click:** Secondary action, typically for context menus.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Scroll up/down for navigation. Pressing the scroll wheel acts as a middle click.
- **Side Buttons:** Default functions may include forward/back in web browsers. These are programmable via Bloody7 software.

DPI Adjustment

The A60L mouse allows for on-the-fly DPI adjustment. Use the dedicated DPI buttons (usually located near the scroll wheel) to cycle through preset DPI levels. The current DPI setting may be indicated by LED colors or patterns, which can be customized in the Bloody7 software.

Weapon Modes (Left Key)

The mouse features 3 distinct weapon modes for the left click button, allowing for different firing behaviors in games. These modes can typically be cycled using a dedicated button, often labeled '1', 'N', '3' or similar, near the scroll wheel. Refer to the Bloody7 software for detailed configuration of these modes.

The Bloody7 software is the central hub for customizing your A60L mouse. It allows you to:

- **Program Buttons:** Assign custom functions, macros, or keyboard shortcuts to any of the 8 programmable buttons.
- **Adjust DPI/CPI:** Fine-tune sensitivity levels and create multiple DPI profiles for different scenarios or games.
- **Manage Macros:** Create, edit, and save complex macro sequences for in-game actions.
- **Customize RGB Lighting:** Personalize the mouse's LED lighting effects, colors, and brightness.
- **Update Firmware:** Ensure your mouse has the latest performance enhancements and features.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cable Management:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the mouse cable to prevent damage.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the mouse in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures.

Problem	Solution
Mouse not responding	Check USB connection. Try a different USB port. Restart your computer. Ensure drivers are installed.
DPI/Sensitivity issues	Adjust DPI using on-mouse buttons. Check and configure DPI settings in Bloody7 software.
Buttons not working as expected	Verify button assignments in Bloody7 software. Reset to default settings if necessary.
Cursor erratic or jumpy	Clean the optical sensor. Ensure mouse pad surface is clean and suitable.
