INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your GForce GF-P1701-1129 Electric Air Fryer. This appliance is designed to cook food using rapid hot air circulation, offering a method to prepare various dishes with little to no added oil. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: To prevent electric shock, fire, or injury, always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances.

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance complies with all electromagnetic field (EMF) standards.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your GForce Air Fryer:

- **Temperature Control Dial:** Used to set the desired cooking temperature.
- **Timer Dial:** Used to set the cooking time (0-30 minutes). The appliance automatically shuts off when the timer reaches zero.
- **Removable Frying Basket:** The primary cooking container for food.
- **Handle:** For safely pulling out and inserting the frying basket.
- **Air Outlet Vent:** Located at the rear, for hot air exhaust.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the air fryer and all packaging materials.
2. **Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the frying basket and pan with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive

sponge. Wipe the inside and outside of the appliance with a damp cloth.

3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, horizontal, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is at least 10 cm (4 inches) of free space at the back and sides of the appliance, and 10 cm (4 inches) above it.
4. **Preheating (Optional):** For best results, preheat the air fryer for 3-5 minutes at the desired cooking temperature before adding food.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to operate your GForce Air Fryer:

1. **Prepare Food:** Place the ingredients you wish to air fry into the removable frying basket. Do not overfill the basket to ensure even cooking.
2. **Insert Basket:** Slide the frying basket back into the air fryer until it clicks securely into place.
3. **Set Temperature:** Turn the temperature control dial to your desired cooking temperature (80-200°C).
4. **Set Timer:** Turn the timer dial to the required cooking time (0-30 minutes). The air fryer will begin heating.
5. **Monitor Cooking:** During cooking, you may pull out the basket to shake or turn ingredients for even browning. The air fryer will pause when the basket is removed and resume when reinserted.
6. **Completion:** When the timer reaches zero, the air fryer will automatically shut off. A bell sound will indicate that cooking is complete.
7. **Remove Food:** Carefully pull out the frying basket using the handle. Use heat-resistant tongs to remove the cooked food.
8. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet after use.

COOKING GUIDE

The GForce Air Fryer is versatile and can be used for various dishes. Here are some common applications:

- **French Fries:** Achieve crispy fries with significantly less oil.
- **Pizza:** Reheat or cook small pizzas to a perfect crisp.
- **Cakes:** Bake small cakes or muffins in suitable bakeware placed inside the basket.
- **Other Snacks:** Ideal for chicken nuggets, spring rolls, and other frozen snacks.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your air fryer.

- 1. Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- 2. Clean Basket and Pan:** The frying basket and pan are non-stick. Clean them with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. They may also be dishwasher safe (check product markings).
- 3. Clean Interior:** Wipe the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth. For stubborn residue, use a mild detergent.
- 4. Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- 5. Storage:** Ensure all parts are dry before storing the air fryer in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not work.	The appliance is not plugged in. The timer is not set.	Plug the main plug into an earthed wall socket. Turn the timer dial to the required cooking time.
Food is not cooked evenly.	Too much food in the basket. Food not shaken or turned.	Reduce the amount of food per batch. Shake or turn food halfway through cooking.
White smoke comes from the appliance.	Fat residues from previous use. Basket or pan not cleaned properly.	Clean the basket and pan thoroughly after each use. Ensure no fat residue remains.
Fresh fries are not crispy.	Not enough oil used. Potato type not suitable.	Add a small amount of oil to the fries before air frying. Use fresh potatoes suitable for frying.
