


Image: The Frigidaire 241796406 Fill Tube, an essential component for water dispensing in compatible appliances.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Frigidaire 241796406 Fill Tube is an OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) authorized part. It is designed to facilitate the flow of water within compatible Frigidaire appliances, typically for ice makers or water dispensers. This component ensures the correct amount of water is delivered to its intended destination.

Note: Electrolux and Frigidaire are interchangeable names for the same brand. The item received may be branded under either name.

COMPATIBILITY AND MODEL VERIFICATION

INSTALLATION GUIDE

This section provides general guidance for installing a fill tube. Specific steps may vary depending on your appliance model. Refer to your appliance's service manual for detailed, model-specific instructions.

1. Preparation:

- Ensure the appliance is unplugged and the water supply is turned off.

- Clear the work area around the appliance.
- Gather necessary tools (e.g., screwdriver, pliers, towels for water spills).

2. Access the Fill Tube:

- Locate the existing fill tube. This may require removing access panels or components, depending on the appliance.

MAINTENANCE

The Frigidaire 241796406 Fill Tube is designed for durability and typically requires minimal maintenance. However, regular inspection can help prevent future issues:

- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically check the fill tube for any signs of wear, cracks, or blockages.
- **Leak Detection:** If you notice water leaks around the fill tube area, immediately disconnect power and water supply and investigate the cause.
- **Cleaning:** If accessible, ensure the tube remains free of mineral buildup or debris that could impede water flow.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues related to water dispensing or ice production after replacing the fill tube, consider the following:

- **No Water Flow:**
 - Check if the water supply valve is fully open.
 - Ensure the appliance is receiving power.
 - Inspect the fill tube for kinks or blockages.
 - Verify that all connections are secure.

- **Water Leaks:**

- Immediately turn off water and power.
- Inspect all connections for tightness.
- Check the fill tube itself for any cracks or damage.
- Ensure gaskets or seals are properly seated.

- **Slow Water Flow:**

- Check water pressure to the appliance.
- Inspect for partial blockages or mineral buildup within the tube.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, contact customer support or a qualified technician.






