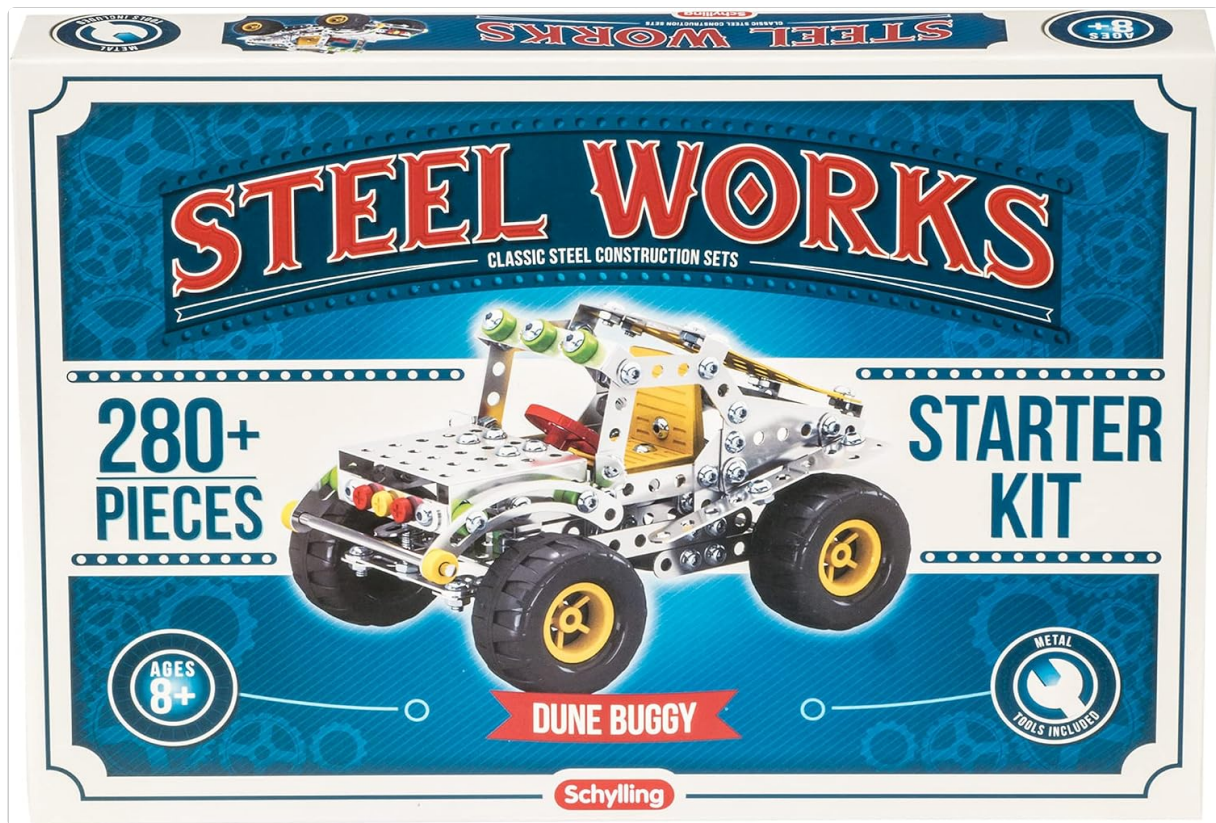


Image: The product box for the Schylling Steel Works Dune Buggy, showing the assembled model and indicating "280+ Pieces" and "Ages 8+".

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

6. **Final Check:** Once assembly is complete, inspect the entire model to confirm all parts are correctly attached and secure.
