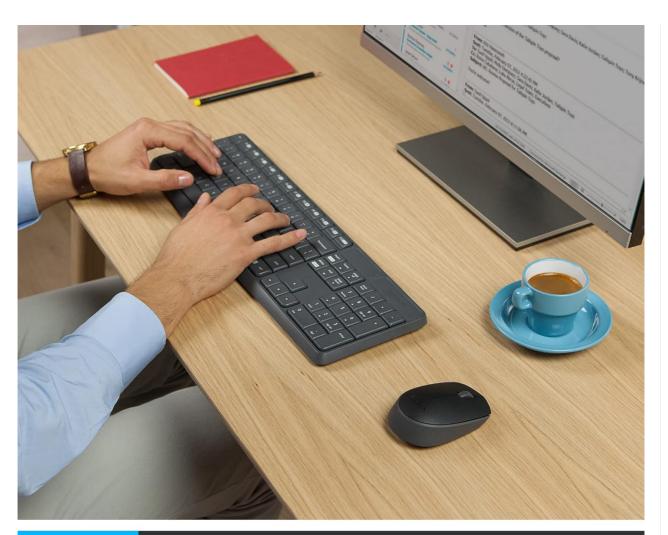

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Insert Batteries:** Open the battery compartments on both the keyboard and the mouse. Insert the provided 2 AAA batteries into the keyboard and 1 AA battery into the mouse, ensuring correct polarity.
- 2. **Connect USB Receiver:** Locate the tiny USB receiver. Plug this receiver into an available USB port on your computer (PC, Linux, or Desktop Computer).

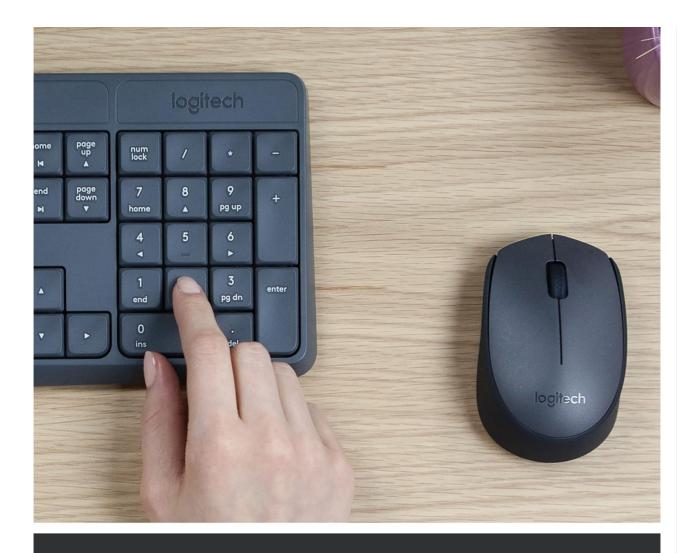

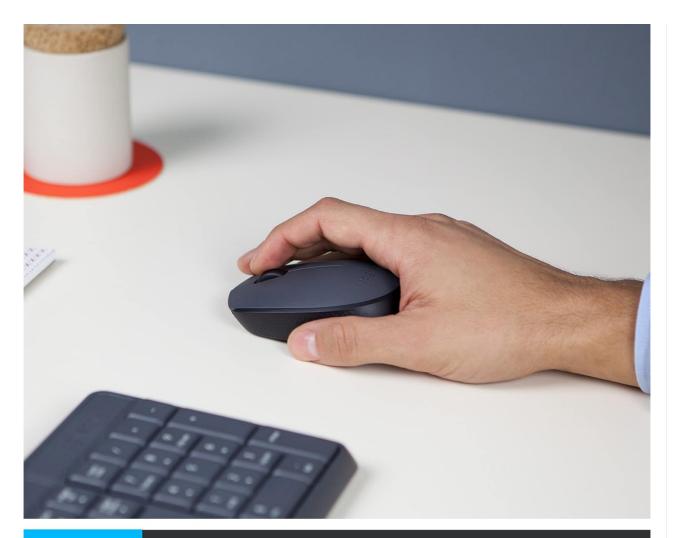
FULL-SIZED KEYBOARD WITH NUBMER PAD

• **Ambidextrous Design:** The compact optical mouse is designed to be comfortable for both left-handed and right-handed users.





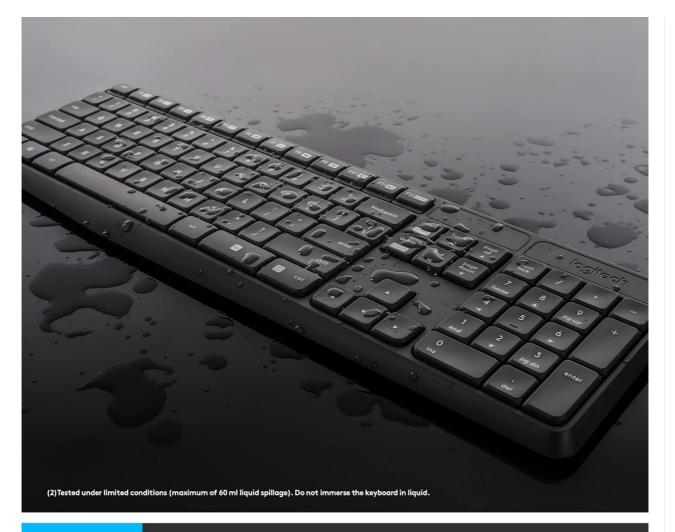

MAINTENANCE

- Anti-Fading Treatment: Keys are treated to resist fading, ensuring legends remain visible over time.
- Cleaning: Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the surfaces of the keyboard and mouse. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Logitech MK235 combo, try the following steps:

• No Connection:

- Ensure the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer.
- Check the mouse's power switch (if applicable) to ensure it is turned 'ON'.
- Replace batteries in both the keyboard and mouse with fresh ones.
- Try plugging the USB receiver into a different USB port or a different computer to isolate the issue.

• Lag or Intermittent Connection:

- Move the keyboard and mouse closer to the USB receiver.
- Avoid placing the receiver near other electrical devices that might cause interference (e.g., speakers, monitors, large metal objects).

• Keys Not Responding:

- Ensure the keyboard batteries are fresh.
- Gently clean around the affected keys to remove any debris.
