# Sunbeam AERO Ceramic Soleplate Iron

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Sunbeam AERO Ceramic Soleplate Iron. This manual provides important information for the safe and efficient operation of your new iron. Please read it thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the iron.
- Use the iron only for its intended use.
- To protect against a risk of electric shock, do not immerse the iron in water or other liquids.
- The iron should always be turned to OFF before plugging or unplugging from outlet. Never yank cord to disconnect from outlet; instead, grasp plug and pull to disconnect.
- Do not allow cord to touch hot surfaces. Let iron cool completely before putting away. Loop cord loosely around iron when storing.
- Always disconnect iron from electrical outlet when filling with water or emptying, and when not in use.
- Do not operate iron with a damaged cord or if the iron has been dropped or damaged. To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not disassemble the iron. Contact qualified service personnel for examination and repair. Incorrect reassembly can cause a risk of electric shock when the iron is used.
- Close supervision is necessary for any appliance being used by or near children. Do not leave iron unattended while connected or on an ironing board.
- Burns can occur from touching hot metal parts, hot water, or steam. Use caution when you turn a steam iron upside down – there may be hot water in the reservoir.

## PARTS AND FEATURES

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Sunbeam AERO Iron:

- **Ceramic Soleplate:** Features dimpling and channeling technology for smooth gliding and efficient steam distribution.
- **Water Fill Opening:** For adding water to the reservoir.
- **Temperature Control Dial:** Adjusts heat settings for various fabric types.
- **Steam/Dry Selector:** Toggles between steam and dry ironing.
- **Shot of Steam Button:** Delivers a powerful burst of steam.
- **Spray Mist Button:** Releases a fine mist for stubborn wrinkles.
- **Self-Clean Button:** Activates the self-cleaning function.
- **Power Cord:** Provides electrical connection.

## SETUP

1. **Before First Use:** Remove any labels, protective covers, or stickers from the iron's soleplate. It is normal for a small amount of smoke or odor to occur during the first use as manufacturing oils burn off. This is temporary and harmless.
2. **Filling the Water Reservoir:** Ensure the iron is unplugged. Open the water fill cover. Using a clean measuring cup, slowly pour tap water into the water fill opening until it reaches the 'MAX FILL' line. Do not overfill. Close the water fill cover securely.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the iron into a standard electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Temperature Setting

1. Turn the Temperature Control Dial to the desired fabric setting (e.g., Synthetic, Silk, Wool, Cotton, Linen). Refer to garment care labels for recommended settings.
2. Allow the iron to heat up. The indicator light will turn off when the selected temperature is reached.

### Steam Ironing

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled.
2. Set the Temperature Control Dial to a steam-appropriate setting (typically Wool, Cotton, or Linen). Steam will not be generated at lower temperatures.
3. Slide the Steam/Dry Selector to the steam position.
4. Once the iron reaches temperature, steam will begin to emit from the soleplate.

5. For an extra burst of steam, press the Shot of Steam button. This is useful for stubborn wrinkles.

## Dry Ironing

1. Ensure the water reservoir is empty or slide the Steam/Dry Selector to the dry position.
2. Set the Temperature Control Dial to the desired fabric setting.
3. Proceed with ironing as normal.

## Vertical Steaming

The Shot of Steam feature can be used for vertical steaming of hanging garments or draperies.

1. Hang the garment or drapery.
2. Hold the iron in an upright position, close to but not touching the fabric.
3. Press the Shot of Steam button repeatedly to release bursts of steam, moving the iron up and down the fabric.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

### Cleaning the Soleplate

- Allow the iron to cool completely.
- Wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive liquid cleaner. Do not use harsh scouring pads or metal cleaners.

### Self-Clean Function

Regularly use the self-clean function to remove mineral buildup and maintain optimal steam performance.

1. Fill the water reservoir to the 'MAX FILL' line.
2. Plug in the iron and set the Temperature Control Dial to the highest setting.
3. Once the iron reaches temperature, unplug it.
4. Hold the iron horizontally over a sink. Press and hold the Self-Clean button. Hot water and steam will flush out mineral deposits.
5. Gently rock the iron back and forth until the reservoir is empty.
6. Plug the iron back in and heat it to dry the soleplate. Unplug and store once cool.

### Storage

Always store the iron upright on its heel rest to prevent water leakage from the soleplate. Ensure the iron is completely cool before storing.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; auto shut-off activated.	Check power connection; test outlet; move iron to reactivate.
No steam or insufficient steam.	Water reservoir empty; temperature too low for steam; steam selector on dry.	Fill reservoir; increase temperature setting; slide selector to steam.
Water leaks from soleplate.	Temperature too low for steam; overfilled reservoir; iron stored horizontally with water.	Increase temperature; do not overfill; store iron upright.
Soleplate is sticking or dirty.	Residue buildup from starches or fabric finishes.	Clean soleplate as per maintenance instructions.


