- 3. Power the Hub: Connect the power adapter to the hub and plug it into an electrical outlet.
- 4. **Connect to Computer:** Connect the USB cable from the hub to your computer (laptop or desktop). The system is plug-and-play and should be recognized automatically.
- 5. **Launch Software:** Open your preferred video conferencing application (e.g., Microsoft Teams, Zoom, WebEx). Select the Logitech Group camera and speakerphone as your audio and video devices within the application settings.




Figure 2: Logitech Group system connected to a laptop for immediate use.

# **Camera Controls**

The camera can be controlled using the included remote control or the buttons on the speakerphone. It features smooth and quiet pan, tilt, and zoom functions.

- Pan: Rotate the camera horizontally up to 350 degrees.
- Tilt: Adjust the camera vertically from +35° to -45°.
- **Zoom:** Utilize the 10x optical zoom to focus on participants or objects.
- Autofocus: The camera features automatic focus adjustment.

# **Remote Control and Presets**

The remote control allows for convenient adjustment of camera position and zoom. You can save up to 10 preset camera positions for quick recall during meetings.

- Saving a Preset: Position the camera as desired, then press and hold a numbered preset button (1-9) on the remote until you hear a confirmation tone.
- Recalling a Preset: Press the desired numbered preset button briefly to move the camera to the saved position.
- Home Position: Press the Home button to return the camera to its default, wide-angle view.

- Poor Video Quality: Check your internet connection speed. Ensure the camera lens is clean and free from obstructions.


  Adjust lighting in the room if necessary.
