1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions carefully before using the appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury to persons, or damage when using the oven. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the oven is properly grounded. Do not operate the oven with a damaged cord or plug.
- **Installation:** This appliance must be installed by a qualified technician in accordance with the installation instructions.
- **Child Safety:** Do not leave children unattended near the oven. The oven surfaces can become hot during operation.
- **Hot Surfaces:** Use oven mitts when handling hot items from the oven.
- **Flammable Materials:** Do not store flammable materials in or near the oven.
- **Self-Cleaning Cycle:** Remove all racks and large food particles before starting the self-cleaning cycle. Do not use oven cleaners during the self-cleaning cycle.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Haier HCW2460AES is a 24-inch electric single wall oven designed for efficient and versatile cooking. It features true European convection for even heat distribution and a self-cleaning system for easy maintenance.

- Self-cleaning system for convenient maintenance.
- Two oven racks with four possible positions.
- Stainless steel finish for a modern aesthetic.

3. INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the safe and efficient operation of your Haier electric wall oven. It is highly recommended that installation be performed by a qualified electrician or appliance installer.

Pre-Installation Checklist:

- Verify that the electrical supply meets the requirements specified on the product rating label.
- Ensure the cabinet cutout dimensions are appropriate for the oven.
- Confirm all packing materials have been removed from the oven cavity and exterior.

- **Overall Height:** 25.25 inches
- **Cutout Width:** 23.44 inches
- **Cutout Depth:** 22.17 inches

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Haier electric wall oven offers various cooking modes to suit your culinary needs. Familiarize yourself with the control knobs and their functions.

Control Panel:

The oven features three main control knobs:

1. **Temperature Knob:** Used to set the desired cooking temperature.
2. **Function Knob:** Selects the cooking mode (e.g., Bake, Broil, Convection Bake).
3. **Timer Knob:** Sets the cooking duration or a simple kitchen timer.

Cooking Modes:

- **Bake:** Standard baking for cakes, cookies, and casseroles.
- **Broil:** High heat from the top element for searing and browning.
- **Convection Bake:** Uses the rear fan and heating element to circulate hot air for even, faster baking. Ideal for multiple racks of food.
- **Convection Broil:** Combines broiling with convection for faster, more even browning.
- **Convection Roast:** Ideal for roasting meats and poultry, ensuring a crispy exterior and juicy interior.
- **Defrost:** Circulates air at room temperature to safely defrost frozen foods.

Using Oven Racks:

The oven comes with two racks and offers four possible positions. Adjust rack positions before preheating to ensure optimal cooking results for different food types and sizes.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular maintenance and cleaning will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Haier electric wall oven.

Self-Cleaning System:

The self-cleaning feature uses high temperatures to burn off food soils, leaving a powdery ash that can be wiped away. Follow these steps:

1. Remove all oven racks, broiler pans, and any other accessories from the oven cavity.
2. Wipe up any loose food particles or spills.
3. Close the oven door securely.
4. Select the self-clean cycle duration (refer to your control panel for options).
5. Once the cycle is complete and the oven has cooled, wipe away the ash with a damp cloth.

Caution: Do not use commercial oven cleaners or oven liners during the self-cleaning cycle, as they can damage the oven's interior.

Exterior Cleaning:

Clean the stainless steel exterior with a soft cloth and a mild detergent or a specialized stainless steel cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that can scratch the surface.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, refer to the following common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven not heating	Power supply issue, incorrect settings, faulty heating element.	Check circuit breaker. Ensure oven is set to a cooking mode and temperature. If problem persists, contact service.
Uneven cooking	Improper rack position, overloaded oven, dirty convection fan.	Adjust rack position. Avoid overcrowding. Clean convection fan if accessible and dirty.
Self-clean cycle not working	Oven door not fully latched, excessive soil.	Ensure door is completely closed. Remove large food spills before starting.
Oven light not working	Bulb needs replacement.	Replace the oven light bulb (refer to the full manual for bulb type and replacement instructions).
