### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up and begin watching your WWE: WrestleMania 32 DVD.

1. **Unpack the DVD:** Carefully remove the DVD discs from their packaging.

2. **Prepare Your DVD Player:** Ensure your DVD player is connected to your television or display device and is powered on. Refer to your DVD player's manual for specific connection instructions if needed.
3. **Insert the Disc:** Open the DVD player's disc tray or slot. Gently place the WWE: WrestleMania 32 DVD disc (Disc 1 first) into the tray with the label side facing up. Close the disc tray.

- **Skip Chapter:** Use the 'Next Chapter' or 'Previous Chapter' buttons to jump to the beginning of the next or previous segment.
- **Menu:** Press the 'Menu' button to access the DVD's main menu, where you can select specific matches, features, or language options.
- **Disc Switching:** This set contains multiple discs. When prompted, remove the current disc and insert the next disc to continue the full event or bonus features.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper care will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your DVD set.

- **Handling:** Always hold discs by their edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface.
- **Cleaning:** If a disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh chemical cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store discs in their original cases, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. Lay discs flat or store them vertically to prevent warping.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Keep discs away from sharp objects and rough surfaces to prevent scratches that can affect playback quality.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
-------	----------------	----------

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Disc not playing or loading	Disc inserted incorrectly, dirty/scratched disc, incorrect region code, player malfunction.	Ensure disc is inserted label-side up. Clean the disc. Check if your player supports Region 1 DVDs (US/Canada). Try another DVD to confirm player functionality.
Skipping or freezing during playback	Dirty or scratched disc, disc defect, player lens dirty.	Clean the disc thoroughly. Try playing the disc in another player. If the issue persists, the disc may be damaged.
No audio or poor sound quality	Incorrect audio settings, loose cables, TV/receiver volume too low.	Check audio cable connections between player and TV/receiver. Adjust volume levels. Check DVD player's audio output settings.
No video or poor picture quality	Loose video cables, incorrect TV input, TV settings.	Ensure video cables are securely connected. Select the correct input on your TV. Adjust TV picture settings.
