1. INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Dell Optiplex 760 Desktop Computer Bundle. The Dell Optiplex 760 is a reliable and efficient desktop system designed for various computing needs, featuring an Intel E7400 Core2 Duo processor, 4GB of memory, a 250GB hard drive, and integrated Wi-Fi capabilities. This bundle includes a 17-inch Ultrasharp Monitor and comes pre-installed with Windows 7.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Dell Optiplex 760 Desktop Computer:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all components from their packaging. Place the desktop unit and monitor on a stable, flat surface.
2. **Connect Monitor:**
 - Connect one end of the VGA or DVI cable to the corresponding port on the back of the Dell Optiplex 760 desktop unit.
 - Connect the other end of the cable to the video input port on the back of the 17-inch Ultrasharp Monitor.
3. **Connect Keyboard and Mouse:**
 - Plug the USB connectors of the keyboard and mouse into any available USB ports on the back of the desktop unit. The Dell Optiplex 760 typically has multiple USB 2.0 ports.
4. **Connect Power Cables:**
 - Connect the desktop PC power cable to the power input on the back of the desktop unit and then to a wall outlet or surge protector.
 - Connect the monitor power cable to the power input on the back of the monitor and then to a wall outlet or surge protector.
5. **Network Connection (Optional):**
 - For wired internet, connect an Ethernet cable from your router/modem to the Ethernet port on the back of the desktop unit.
 - For wireless internet, the system includes Wi-Fi. Drivers may need to be installed or updated for optimal performance.

4. OPERATING YOUR DELL OPTIPLEX 760

4.1 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press the power button located on the front of the Dell Optiplex 760 desktop unit. The monitor will also need to be powered on using its dedicated power button.

- **To Power Off:** Click the "Start" button in Windows 7, then select "Shut Down." Do not unplug the computer directly from the power source without proper shutdown, as this can lead to data loss or system corruption.

4.2 Initial Setup and Windows 7

Upon first boot, Windows 7 may guide you through an initial setup process, including setting up user accounts, time zone, and network preferences. Ensure your Windows 7 license is activated as per instructions provided by your vendor.

4.3 Key Features

- **Processor:** Intel E7400 Core2 Duo 2.8Ghz for reliable performance.
- **Memory:** 4GB DDR2 RAM for efficient multitasking.
- **Storage:** 250GB Hard Drive for ample storage of documents, media, and applications.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Computer does not power on.	Loose power cable, faulty power outlet.	Ensure all power cables are securely connected. Try a different power outlet.
No display on monitor.	Monitor not powered on, loose video cable, incorrect input source.	Ensure monitor is powered on. Check video cable connection (VGA/DVI). Press the monitor's input source button to select the correct input.
Keyboard or mouse not responding.	Loose USB connection, faulty device.	Try plugging the keyboard/mouse into a different USB port. Restart the computer.
Slow system performance.	Too many programs running, low disk space, malware.	Close unnecessary programs. Free up disk space. Run a full antivirus scan.
