INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Trust Asto Sound Bar Speaker. This elegant horizontal speaker is designed to fit ideally below any PC monitor, providing rich stereo sound for your computer, laptop, Mac, or TV. With its compact design and convenient features, it enhances your audio experience for entertainment and productivity.

Key features include:

- 12 W peak power (6 W RMS) for clear audio.
- Compact design to fit below any PC monitor.
- Large, illuminated volume control button for easy adjustment.
- Convenient headphone and microphone connections on the front side.
- USB-powered, eliminating the need for a wall power outlet.

SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your Trust Asto Sound Bar Speaker for optimal performance.

1. Physical Placement

The sound bar is designed to fit elegantly under your PC monitor or TV. Ensure there is enough space for proper ventilation.

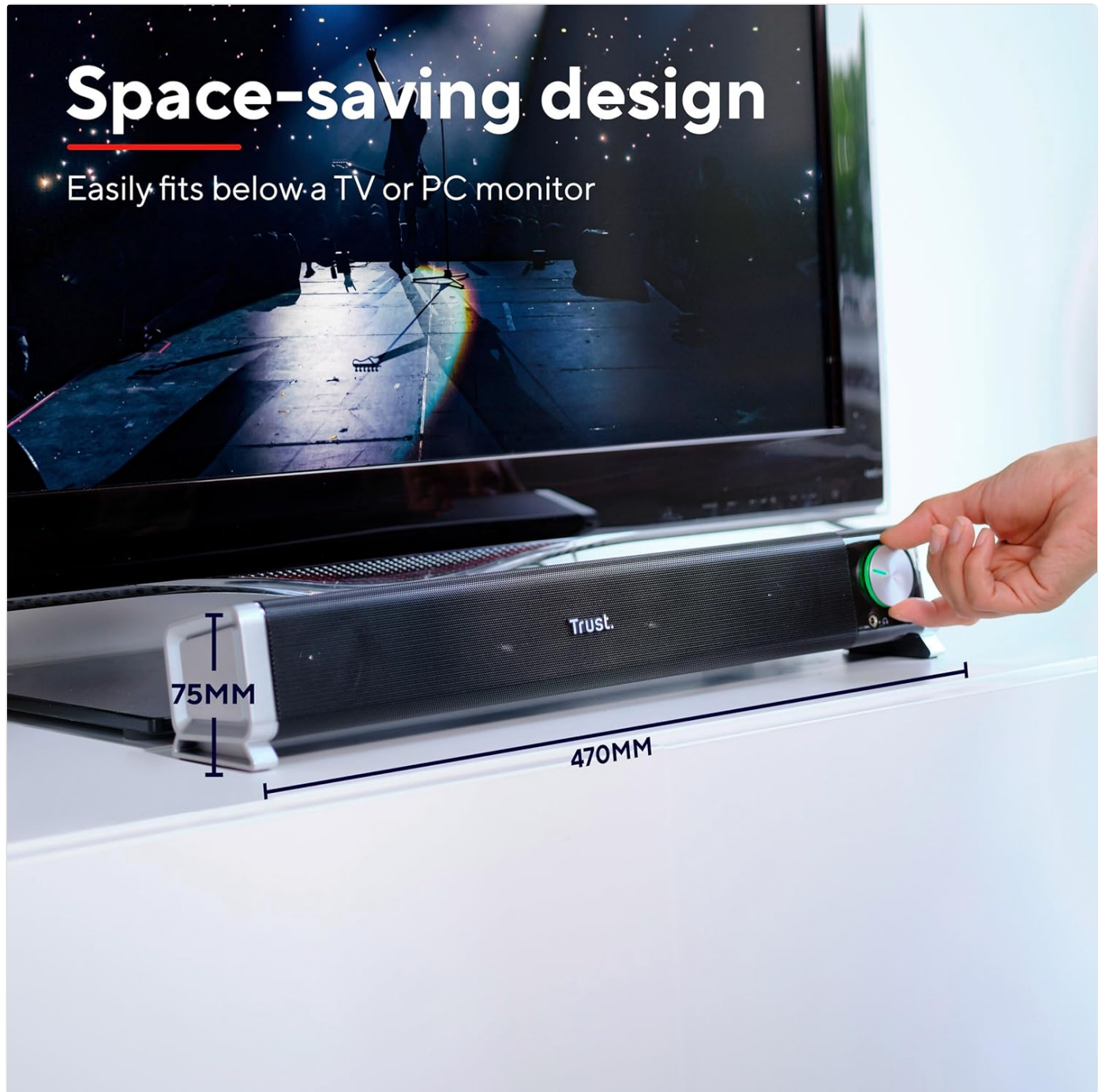


Image: The sound bar positioned beneath a computer monitor, illustrating its space-saving design and approximate dimensions (470mm length, 75mm height).

2. Connecting the Speaker

The Trust Asto Sound Bar Speaker is USB-powered and connects via a 3.5mm audio jack. No separate power adapter is needed.

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the USB cable from the sound bar to an available USB port on your computer, laptop, or a USB wall adapter (not included). The speaker draws power directly from the USB connection.

2. **Audio Connection:** Connect the 3.5mm audio jack from the sound bar to the audio output port (usually green) on your computer, laptop, or other audio source.

3. Audio Source Options

The sound bar supports various audio input configurations:

- **Option 1: Device with 2 separate 3.5mm audio connections (e.g., Desktop PC):**
Connect the sound bar's 3.5mm cable to the green audio output jack on your device. If your sound bar cable has separate green (audio out) and pink (microphone in) plugs, connect both to the corresponding ports on your PC.
- **Option 2: Device with 2 RCA (red and white) audio connections (e.g., TV or DVD player):**
You will need an RCA to 3.5mm adapter cable (not included). Connect the RCA ends to your device's audio output and the 3.5mm end to the sound bar's audio input.
- **Option 3: Device with a combined 3.5mm audio connection (e.g., Laptop, Smartphone):**
Connect the sound bar's 3.5mm audio jack directly to the combined audio port on your device. If your sound bar cable has separate audio and mic plugs, you may need a 3.5mm TRRS splitter (not included) to use both functions with a combined port.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once connected, operating your Trust Asto Sound Bar Speaker is straightforward.

1. Power On/Off and Volume Control

- **Power:** The large, illuminated button on the front of the sound bar serves as the power switch. Press it to turn the speaker on or off. The illumination indicates the power status.
- **Volume:** Rotate the large knob on the front of the sound bar clockwise to increase the volume and counter-clockwise to decrease it.

2. Headphone and Microphone Connections

- **Headphone Jack:** Plug your headphones into the port marked with a headphone icon. This will mute the sound bar's speakers and route audio to your headphones.
- **Microphone Jack:** Plug your microphone into the port marked with a microphone icon for voice input.

3. Computer Audio Settings

For optimal performance with a computer, ensure the sound bar is selected as the default audio device:

1. **Windows:** Right-click the speaker icon in the system tray, select "Sound settings" or "Playback devices." Choose the Trust Asto Sound Bar as your default playback device.
2. **macOS:** Go to System Preferences > Sound > Output. Select the Trust Asto Sound Bar from the list of output devices.
3. Adjust the system volume on your computer in addition to the sound bar's physical volume knob for fine-tuning.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your sound bar.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the exterior of the sound bar. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they may damage the finish.
- **Dust:** Regularly dust the speaker grille and control knob to prevent dust buildup, which can affect sound quality and component lifespan.
- **Environment:** Avoid exposing the sound bar to extreme temperatures, humidity, direct sunlight, or excessive dust. Keep it away from liquids.
- **Handling:** Handle the sound bar with care. Do not drop it or subject it to strong impacts.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Trust Asto Sound Bar Speaker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speaker	Speaker is off. Volume is too low. Incorrect audio input selected on computer/device. Audio cable not properly connected. USB power not connected or insufficient. Headphones plugged in.	Press the power button on the sound bar. Increase volume using the knob on the sound bar and on your device. Verify the Trust Asto Sound Bar is set as the default playback device in your device's sound settings. Ensure the 3.5mm audio cable is securely plugged into both the sound bar and the audio source. Ensure the USB cable is connected to a working USB port. Try a different USB port. Unplug headphones from the front jack.
Sound is distorted or unclear	Volume set too high. Poor audio source quality. Loose cable connection.	Reduce the volume on both the sound bar and your device. Test with a different audio source or file. Check all cable connections for tightness.
Microphone not working	Microphone not properly connected. Incorrect input device selected on computer.	Ensure microphone is securely plugged into the microphone jack on the sound bar. In your device's sound settings, ensure the correct microphone input (e.g., "Microphone (Trust Asto Sound Bar)") is selected as the default recording device.
