# Ibanez SR405E SR Standard 5-String Bass Guitar Instruction Manual

Model: SR405E

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Ibanez SR405E SR Standard 5-String Electric Bass Guitar. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your instrument.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Ibanez SR405E is a 5-string electric bass guitar designed for versatility and playability. Key features include:

- **Body:** Mahogany body with a quilt maple top, finished in Dragon Eye Burst.
- **Neck:** 5-piece Maple/Rosewood neck, designed for comfortable playability.
- **Fretboard:** Jatoba fretboard.
- **Pickups:** Two PowerSpan humbucking pickups for a wide range of tones.
- **Electronics:** 3-band EQ for precise tonal shaping.
- **Bridge:** Fixed bridge for stable tuning and intonation.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Initial Inspection

Upon unboxing, carefully inspect the instrument for any signs of damage. Ensure all components are securely attached.

### 3.2 Tuning

Tune the bass to standard B-E-A-D-G tuning using a reliable electronic tuner. The tuning machines are located on the headstock.

### 3.3 Stringing

When replacing strings, ensure you use 5-string bass guitar strings of appropriate gauge. Thread the string through the bridge, over the saddle, and wind it securely around the tuning post. Stretch new strings gently to help them settle and hold tune.

### 3.4 Action Adjustment

The string action (height of strings above the fretboard) can be adjusted at the bridge saddles. Use the

provided Allen wrenches to raise or lower individual saddles to achieve your preferred playing feel. Adjustments to the truss rod (located under the cover on the headstock) may be necessary for neck relief, but this is typically a task for experienced technicians.

## 4. OPERATING THE CONTROLS

---

The Ibanez SR405E features active electronics with a 3-band EQ for versatile tone shaping. A 9V battery is required to power the active electronics.

- **Volume Knobs:** Individual volume controls for the neck and bridge pickups. Adjust these to blend the output of each pickup.
- **Tone Knob:** Global tone control for overall brightness.
- **3-Band EQ:** Controls for Bass, Mid, and Treble frequencies. These allow you to boost or cut specific frequency ranges to tailor your sound. Experiment with these controls to find your desired tone.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

### 5.1 Cleaning

Regularly wipe down your bass with a soft, dry cloth after playing to remove sweat and fingerprints. For a deeper clean, use guitar-specific cleaning products. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.

### 5.2 String Replacement

Strings should be replaced periodically, depending on playing frequency and personal preference. Worn strings can affect tone and playability. Refer to section 3.3 for stringing instructions.

### 5.3 Battery Replacement

The active electronics are powered by a 9V battery. When the sound becomes weak or distorted, it's likely time to replace the battery. The battery compartment is located on the back of the body. Ensure proper polarity when inserting a new battery.

### 5.4 Storage

Store your bass in a stable environment, away from extreme temperature changes or humidity fluctuations, which can damage the wood. A gig bag or hard case is recommended for protection.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **No Sound:**
  - Check if the instrument cable is securely connected to both the bass and the amplifier.
  - Ensure the amplifier is turned on and volume is up.
  - Verify the bass's volume knobs are not turned down.
  - Replace the 9V battery if the electronics are active.
- **Buzzing/Humming:**
  - Check for proper grounding of your amplifier and cables.
  - Ensure all control cavity screws are tight.
  - If the buzzing is from the strings, check string action and neck relief.


