


Image: Cover of the John Deere 100 Lawn & Garden Tractor Operators Manual. This image displays the front cover of the instruction manual, which

SETUP AND PRE-OPERATION CHECKS

2. **Inspect Tires:** Check tire pressure and for any signs of damage or excessive wear.

5. **Safety Interlocks:** Test all safety interlock systems (e.g., seat switch, PTO engagement) to ensure they are functioning correctly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Starting the Engine

1. Ensure the parking brake is engaged.
2. Place the PTO (Power Take-Off) lever in the disengaged position.
3. Ensure the transmission is in neutral or the clutch pedal is fully depressed (if applicable).
4. Insert the key into the ignition switch.
5. Turn the key to the "START" position. Release the key once the engine starts.
6. Allow the engine to warm up for a few minutes before engaging in heavy work.

Driving and Mowing

- **Engaging Transmission:** Gradually release the parking brake and engage the transmission as per your model's specific shift pattern.
- **Steering:** Use the steering wheel to guide the tractor. Be mindful of turning radius, especially with

attachments.

- **Mower Deck Engagement:** To engage the mower deck, ensure the engine is running at the recommended RPM, then slowly engage the PTO lever.
- **Cutting Height Adjustment:** Adjust the mower deck height using the designated lever or knob.
- **Safe Mowing Practices:** Mow at a safe speed, especially on uneven terrain or slopes. Overlap cutting paths slightly for an even cut.

Stopping the Engine

1. Disengage the PTO.
2. Engage the parking brake.
3. Place the transmission in neutral.
4. Turn the ignition key to the "OFF" position and remove it.

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURES

Regular maintenance is crucial for the performance and longevity of your John Deere 100 Lawn & Garden Tractor. Refer to the detailed maintenance schedule in the original manual for specific intervals.

Daily / Every 8 Hours of Operation

- Check engine oil level.
- Check coolant level.
- Inspect mower blades for sharpness and damage.
- Clean debris from engine cooling fins and mower deck.
- Check tire pressure.

Every 50 Hours of Operation / Annually

- Change engine oil and oil filter.
- Clean or replace air filter.
- Inspect spark plug(s) and replace if necessary.
- Lubricate all grease points.
- Check and adjust brake pedal free play.
- Inspect drive belts for wear and tension.

Seasonal Storage

- Clean the tractor thoroughly.
- Perform an oil change.
- Add fuel stabilizer to the fuel tank or drain the fuel system.
- Remove and store the battery in a cool, dry place, keeping it charged.
- Lubricate all moving parts.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine Fails to Start	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No fuel • Dead battery • Safety interlock engaged • Spark plug issue 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add fresh fuel. • Charge or replace battery. • Ensure PTO is disengaged, parking brake is on, and operator is in seat. • Inspect and clean/replace spark plug.
Poor Mowing Performance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dull or damaged blades • Incorrect cutting height • Engine RPM too low • Mower deck clogged 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharpen or replace blades. • Adjust cutting height. • Increase engine throttle. • Clean underside of mower deck.
Excessive Vibration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unbalanced or bent blades • Loose components 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inspect and replace damaged blades. • Check and tighten all fasteners.
