INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, use, and care of your Axxid Minikid/Kidzone Adjustment Wedge. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

The Axxid Adjustment Wedge is designed to improve the installation and recline angle of compatible Axxid car seats, ensuring a better fit and enhanced comfort for the child.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The adjustment wedge is a simple yet effective accessory for your Axkid car seat. It is specifically designed to be placed under the car seat base to achieve a more optimal recline angle, which can be particularly beneficial in vehicles with sloped seats or for younger children who require a more reclined position.

Compatibility: This adjustment wedge is compatible with Axkid Minikid, Kidzone, Duofix, and Rekid car seats.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation of the adjustment wedge is crucial for the safety and stability of the car seat. Always refer to your specific Axkid car seat manual for detailed installation instructions, as the wedge is an accessory to the car seat.

1. **Prepare the Vehicle Seat:** Ensure the vehicle seat where the car seat will be installed is clean and free of debris.
2. **Position the Wedge:** Place the Axkid Adjustment Wedge on the vehicle seat where the car seat base will rest. Ensure it is centered and aligned with the car seat's footprint. The contoured side of the wedge should face upwards, ready to cradle the car seat base.
3. **Install the Car Seat:** Carefully place your compatible Axkid car seat (Minikid, Kidzone, Duofix, or Rekid) on top of the adjustment wedge.
4. **Secure the Car Seat:** Proceed with the standard installation of your Axkid car seat as per its instruction manual. This typically involves securing it with the vehicle's seat belt or ISOFIX system, and tightening any tether straps or support legs. The wedge should remain firmly in place beneath the car seat.
5. **Check Stability:** After installation, firmly push and pull on the car seat at the belt path to ensure it is securely installed and does not move more than 2.5 cm (1 inch) in any direction. The wedge should not shift or become dislodged.

Important: The adjustment wedge is designed to provide an optimal recline angle. Do not use it if it compromises the stability or proper installation of your car seat. Always ensure the car seat is installed according to its own manual and local safety regulations.

OPERATING (USAGE)

The Axkid Adjustment Wedge is a passive component that, once installed, works in conjunction with your car seat to provide an improved recline angle. There are no active "operating" steps for the wedge itself beyond its initial installation.

The primary benefit of using the wedge is to achieve a more reclined position for the car seat, which can help prevent a child's head from falling forward, especially during sleep, and improve overall comfort. This is particularly useful in vehicles where the back seats have a steep angle.

Always ensure the child is properly secured in the car seat according to the car seat's instructions, regardless of whether the wedge is in use.

MAINTENANCE

The Axkid Adjustment Wedge requires minimal maintenance.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wedge with a damp cloth and mild soap if it becomes dirty. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Allow it to air dry completely before re-installation.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the wedge for any signs of damage, cracks, or deformation. If the wedge is damaged, it should be replaced immediately.
- **Storage:** Store the wedge in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.

Note: The product is not dishwasher safe.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues related to the adjustment wedge will stem from improper installation or compatibility concerns.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car seat is still too upright or not reclined enough.	Vehicle seat angle is very steep; wedge may not provide sufficient recline for extreme angles.	Ensure the wedge is correctly positioned. If the issue persists, consult your car seat manual for alternative recline options or contact Axkid support.
Wedge shifts or moves during car seat installation.	Wedge not properly aligned or car seat not secured tightly enough.	Re-position the wedge to ensure it is centered. Re-install the car seat, ensuring all belts/ISOFIX connections are tightened to specification. The car seat should hold the wedge firmly in place.
Wedge appears damaged or deformed.	Physical stress, improper storage, or manufacturing defect.	Discontinue use immediately. A damaged wedge can compromise car seat stability. Replace the wedge.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car seat does not fit properly on the wedge.	Incompatible car seat model.	Verify that your car seat is one of the compatible models (Minikid, Kidzone, Duofix, Rekid). This wedge is not universal.



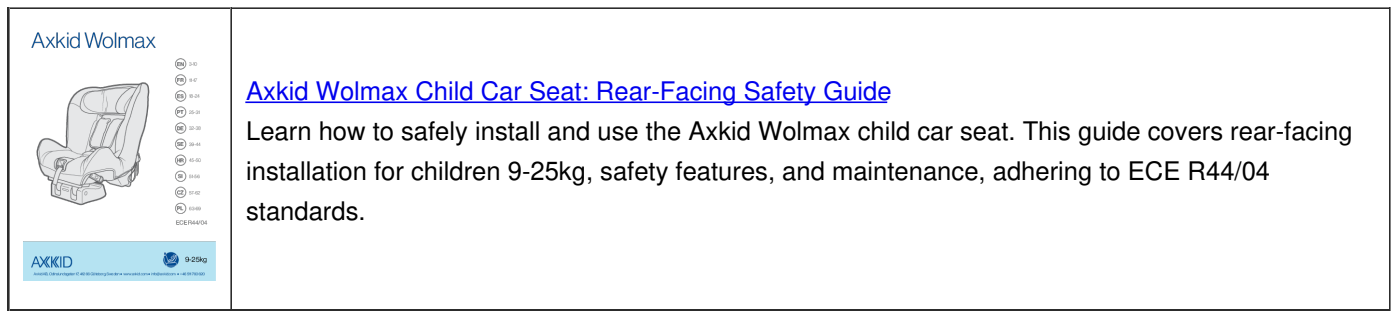
