INTRODUCTION

The Garmin Zumo 395LM is a robust motorcycle GPS navigator designed for adventurous riders. It features a glove-friendly, sunlight-readable display and offers specialized routing options for twisty, hilly roads. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

SETUP




Image: The Zumo 395LM screen displaying a navigation map.

Screen Interaction

The device features a bright, sunlight-readable display and a glove-friendly touchscreen. This design allows for easy operation even while wearing motorcycle gloves. The screen is pressure-sensitive, so smartphone touch gloves are not required.

Rider Alerts

Receive warnings for sharp curves, state helmet laws, speed cameras, and other potential hazards on your route. These alerts enhance safety and awareness during your ride.

Bluetooth Connectivity

Pair your Zumo 395LM with a compatible Bluetooth headset or helmet for hands-free calling and in-helmet directions. You can also control music and media from a compatible MP3 player or smartphone directly from the Zumo screen.

GPX File Management

To import GPX files (e.g., routes planned on external software):

1. Connect the Zumo 395LM to your computer via USB.
2. Copy the GPX file to the device's GPX folder.
3. On the Zumo device, navigate to **Apps > Tracks**.
4. Select the imported track, then tap the **Wrench** icon.
5. Choose **Convert To Trip** to transform the track into a navigable route.

MAINTENANCE

Device Care

The Zumo 395LM is built with a rugged design to withstand harsh weather elements, including fuel vapors, UV rays, and rain. To maintain its condition:

- Clean the screen and device exterior with a soft, damp, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure all port covers are securely closed when not in use to protect against moisture and dust.
- Store the device in a cool, dry place when not in use.

Battery Information

The device is powered by one included Lithium Ion battery, providing approximately 4 hours of battery life. For extended use, connect the device to a power source via the motorcycle or automotive power cables.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Satellite Acquisition Issues:** If the device struggles to acquire satellite signals, ensure you are in an open area away from tall buildings or dense foliage. Moving to a different location or restarting the device may help.
- **GPX File Import Problems:** Ensure GPX files are saved as "Tracks" and then converted to "Trips" within the device as described in the Operating Instructions. Verify the file format is correct.
- **Audio Quality/Volume:** If experiencing poor audio quality or inconsistent volume, check Bluetooth connections and ensure your headset/helmet is properly paired. Adjust volume settings on both the Zumo and your audio device.
- **Screen Readability:** While the screen is designed for sunlight readability, vibration at high speeds can affect text clarity. Ensure the mount is secure to minimize vibration.
- **Device Not Responding:** If the device becomes unresponsive, perform a soft reset by holding down the power button until it restarts.
