INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Your Heritage Ergo Thinner Scissors are ready for use directly out of the packaging. Please follow these steps for initial preparation:

2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the blades and handles with a clean, soft cloth to remove any manufacturing residues.
3. **Hand Orientation:** These scissors are designed for *right-handed orientation*. Ensure comfortable grip and natural movement.
4. **Blade Check:** Gently open and close the scissors a few times to ensure smooth operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Heritage Ergo Thinner Scissors are designed for precise thinning applications. Follow these guidelines for effective use:

- **Grip:** Hold the scissors firmly but comfortably, ensuring your fingers are properly seated in the handle loops.

The ergonomic design of the metal handle provides a secure grip.

- **Thinning Technique:** Position the 21-tooth blade against the section to be thinned. The *convex-concave blade edge* is engineered for smooth cutting and efficient removal of bulk without creating harsh lines.
- **Controlled Movement:** Use smooth, controlled motions to open and close the blades. Avoid forcing the scissors, as this can damage the blades or lead to uneven results.
- **Safety:** Always exercise caution when handling sharp instruments. Keep fingers clear of the blades during operation.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and performance of your Heritage Ergo Thinner Scissors:

- **Cleaning After Each Use:** After each use, wipe the blades clean with a soft, dry cloth to remove any debris. For thorough cleaning, a damp cloth with mild soap can be used, followed immediately by drying to prevent water spots on the *stainless steel blade construction* and *metal handle*.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a small drop of scissor oil to the pivot screw to ensure smooth operation. Open and close the scissors several times to distribute the oil.
- **Storage:** Store the scissors in a dry, safe place, preferably in a protective case or pouch, to prevent damage to the blades and to protect against moisture.
- **Sharpening:** While made from durable stainless steel, all cutting tools eventually require sharpening. It is recommended to have your scissors professionally sharpened to maintain the integrity of the *convex-concave blade edge* and the 21 teeth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Heritage Ergo Thinner Scissors, consider the following:

- **Dullness:** If the scissors feel dull or are not cutting cleanly, they likely require professional sharpening. Avoid attempting to sharpen them yourself unless you are trained in scissor sharpening, as improper sharpening can damage the specialized blade edge.
- **Stiffness:** If the scissors feel stiff or difficult to open and close, clean the pivot area thoroughly and apply a small amount of scissor oil. If stiffness persists, check for any trapped debris.
- **Uneven Cutting:** Ensure the blades are clean and free of any hair or debris. If the issue persists, it may indicate a need for professional adjustment or sharpening.
