1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Bajaj Majesty DX-11 1000W Dry Iron. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain them for future reference.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Bajaj Majesty DX-11 Dry Iron is designed for effective and safe ironing, incorporating several key features:

- **1000 Watts Power:** Provides rapid heating for efficient ironing.
- **Advanced Stainless Steel Soleplate:** Equipped with anti-bacterial German coating technology for smooth gliding and hygiene.
- **Automatic Shut-Off:** Enhances safety by turning off the iron when left unattended.
- **Thermal Safety Fuse:** Offers additional protection against overheating.
- **360° Swivel Cord:** Allows for flexible movement and prevents tangling during use.
- **Multiple Temperature Levels:** Adjustable settings for various fabric types (Nylon, Silk, Wool, Linen/Cotton, Denim).
- **Lightweight and Ergonomic Design:** Ensures comfortable handling and reduced fatigue.
- **Cord Organizer:** For neat and convenient storage.

3. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the iron and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components listed in the 'Included Components' section are present.
2. **First Use:** Before first use, wipe the soleplate with a clean, damp cloth to remove any manufacturing residues. It is normal for a slight odor or smoke to occur during the first heating; this will dissipate quickly.
3. **Placement:** Place the iron on a stable, heat-resistant surface, such as an ironing board. Ensure the power cord is untangled and not obstructing your movement.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Sorting Clothes:** Sort garments according to their fabric composition (e.g., cotton, silk, synthetic). Always check the garment's care label for ironing instructions.

2. **Setting Temperature:** Turn the temperature control knob to the desired setting based on the fabric type. Start with lower temperatures for delicate fabrics and increase for heavier ones. The iron will heat up, and the indicator light will illuminate. It will turn off once the set temperature is reached.
3. **Ironing:** Once the iron reaches the desired temperature, begin ironing. Move the iron smoothly over the fabric. For best results, iron in one direction.
4. **Automatic Shut-Off:** The iron is equipped with an automatic shut-off feature for safety. If left stationary for a period, it will automatically turn off. To reactivate, simply move the iron.
5. **Finishing:** After ironing, turn the temperature control knob to the 'Min' position and unplug the iron from the power outlet. Allow the iron to cool down completely before storing.

5. MAINTENANCE

1. **Cleaning the Soleplate:** After the iron has cooled down, wipe the soleplate with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a specialized soleplate cleaner, following the product's instructions. Do not use abrasive cleaners or

metallic scouring pads, as these can damage the coating.

- Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the iron with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or solvents.
- Storage:** Store the iron upright on its heel rest in a dry, safe place, away from moisture and direct sunlight. Use the cord organizer to wrap the power cord neatly around the iron.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Iron not heating:**

- Check if the iron is properly plugged into a working power outlet.
- Ensure the temperature control knob is set to a heat setting and not 'Min' or 'Off'.
- Verify that the power outlet is functional by plugging in another appliance.

- **Iron sticking to fabric:**

- The temperature setting might be too high for the fabric. Adjust the temperature control knob to a lower setting.
- The soleplate might be dirty. Clean the soleplate as described in the 'Maintenance' section.

- **Smoke or odor during first use:**

- This is normal during the initial heating as manufacturing residues burn off. It should subside after a few minutes. Ensure adequate ventilation.
