1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your Hunter Cassius 52-inch Indoor/Outdoor Ceiling Fan. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning installation or use. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always disconnect power at the circuit breaker before installing or servicing the fan. Ensure all electrical connections comply with local codes and ordinances. The fan must be mounted with a minimum of 7 feet (2.1 meters) clearance from the floor to the blade trailing edge. Do not bend the blade holders during installation or cleaning. Ensure the mounting structure can support the fan's weight. This fan is damp-rated for use in covered outdoor areas like patios and porches, as well as indoor rooms.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation requires basic electrical knowledge. If you are unsure about any steps, consult a qualified electrician. The Hunter Cassius fan offers versatile mounting options to suit various ceiling heights and room types.

Mounting Options:

- Low Profile: Utilizes the 3-inch downrod for a closer-to-ceiling installation.
- Standard: Uses the 5-inch downrod for typical ceiling heights.
- Angled: Suitable for sloped ceilings; a longer 36-inch downrod is required and sold separately.

Ensure the chosen downrod provides optimal distance from the ceiling for efficient air movement. Attach the fan blades securely to the motor housing. Some users have noted that aligning the lower switch housing during assembly may require patience.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Hunter Cassius fan is controlled via a traditional pull chain, offering simplicity and reliability.

Fan Speed Control:

- Pull the chain once to turn the fan ON at high speed.
- Pull the chain again to cycle through medium speed.
- Pull the chain a third time for low speed.
- A fourth pull will turn the fan OFF.

Reversible Airflow:

The fan features a reversible motor for year-round comfort. A small switch on the motor housing allows you to change the direction of blade rotation:

- **Downdraft (Summer):** Blades rotate counter-clockwise, pushing cool air down.
- **Updraft (Winter):** Blades rotate clockwise, drawing cool air up and circulating warm air trapped near the ceiling.

To change the direction, ensure the fan is off and the blades have stopped completely before flipping the switch.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Hunter Cassius fan.

Cleaning:

- Always turn off the power to the fan at the circuit breaker before cleaning.
- Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the fan blades and motor housing. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- For outdoor installations, occasional wiping may be sufficient, as some users have reported minimal dust accumulation even after extended periods.

Periodic Checks:

- Periodically check all screws and connections on the fan and mounting hardware to ensure they are secure.
- No lubrication is required for the motor.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your fan is not operating correctly, consult the following troubleshooting guide:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not start	No power to the fan; loose wire connections; incorrect pull chain setting.	Check circuit breaker and wall switch; ensure all wire connections are secure; pull chain to cycle through speeds.
Fan is noisy	Loose motor housing screws; loose blade attachment screws; fan not properly balanced.	Tighten all screws; ensure blades are securely attached; use a blade balancing kit (sold separately) if necessary.
Fan wobbles	Loose mounting bracket; unbalanced blades; incorrect downrod installation.	Verify mounting bracket is secure; balance blades; ensure downrod is correctly installed and secured.
Low	Fan speed set too low; incorrect blade rotation direction for the season.	Increase fan speed using the pull chain; check the reverse switch on the motor housing and adjust for desired airflow direction.
