INTRODUCTION

The UNIVERSAL REMOTE MX-990 is an advanced IR/RF remote control designed for comprehensive control of your home entertainment and automation systems. Featuring a color LCD screen and extensive device compatibility, the MX-990 offers a powerful solution for managing multiple devices from a single interface.

SETUP AND PROGRAMMING

Important Note: The programming software for the MX-990 is not included with the remote and is typically only provided to authorized Universal Remote Control (URC) dealers and professional installers. Consumers generally cannot program this remote without access to this specialized software and expertise.

1. Battery Installation and Charging

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the MX-990 remote.

- 2. Insert the provided Lithium Ion battery (NP-60 type), ensuring correct polarity.
- 3. Place the remote into the charging cradle. Connect the power adapter to the charging cradle and plug it into a standard electrical outlet.
- 4. Allow the remote to charge fully before initial use. A full charge typically takes several hours.

2. Professional Programming Requirement

Due to the complexity and proprietary nature of the programming software, it is strongly recommended to engage an authorized URC dealer or a professional audio/video installer for the setup and configuration of your MX-990 remote. They possess the necessary software and expertise to:

- Integrate and control up to 255 devices (e.g., televisions, audio receivers, media players, lighting systems).
- Customize macros and sequences for one-touch operation of multiple commands.
- Configure IR (Infrared) and RF (Radio Frequency) communication for various devices.
- Design custom graphical user interfaces on the LCD screen.

Attempting to program the remote without the proper software and knowledge may result in an inoperable device.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once professionally programmed, the MX-990 offers intuitive control over your connected devices. The specific functions of buttons and screen elements will depend on your custom programming.

1. LCD Touch Screen Navigation

- The 2.4-inch color LCD screen displays custom menus, device selections, and activity buttons.
- Touch the desired icon or button on the screen to activate a command or navigate to a different menu.
- The screen will illuminate when motion is detected, conserving battery life.

2. Hard Button Functions

The MX-990 features a variety of tactile buttons for common functions:

- VOL +/-: Adjusts volume.
- CH +/-: Changes channels.
- MUTE: Mutes audio.
- MENU: Accesses device menus.
- GUIDE: Displays program guide.
- INFO: Shows information about current content.
- EXIT: Exits current menu or screen.
- Directional Pad (Up, Down, Left, Right) and SEL (Select): Navigates menus and confirms selections.
- Transport Controls (PLAY, PAUSE, STOP, REW, FF, SKIP-, SKIP+, REC): Controls media playback.
- Numeric Keypad (0-9, ./- , ENT): For direct channel entry or other numeric inputs.
- · Color Buttons (Red, Green, Yellow, Blue): These functions are typically custom-programmed.

MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Care

- Regularly place the MX-990 in its charging cradle when not in use to ensure the battery remains charged.
- If the remote's battery life significantly diminishes, consider replacing the NP-60 Lithium Ion battery. It is recommended to purchase replacement batteries directly from Universal Remote Control or an authorized

dealer to ensure compatibility and longevity.

 Avoid using aftermarket batteries that may not meet the required specifications, as this can lead to unstable voltage or damage to the remote.

2. Cleaning

- To clean the remote, gently wipe the surface with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For stubborn smudges on the LCD screen, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Do not spray liquids directly onto the remote.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish or internal components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Remote Not Responding:

- Ensure the battery is charged. Place the remote in its charging cradle for several hours.
- Verify that the remote is within range of the controlled devices or RF base station (if applicable).
- Confirm that the correct device or activity is selected on the LCD screen.

• Commands Not Executing:

- This is almost always related to programming. If the remote is not performing as expected, it indicates an issue with the custom programming.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote's IR emitter and the device's IR receiver.

· Difficulty with Initial Setup or Changes:

- As noted in the Setup section, the MX-990 requires specialized software and expertise for programming.
 If you are experiencing difficulties, it is crucial to contact an authorized URC dealer or a professional installer.
- Do not attempt to acquire or use unauthorized software, as this may void warranties and lead to irreversible issues.

• Screen Not Turning On:

 Ensure the battery is charged. The screen activates upon motion detection; try picking up or gently shaking the remote.

For complex issues or programming modifications, professional assistance is required. Refer to the "Warranty and Support" section for guidance.
