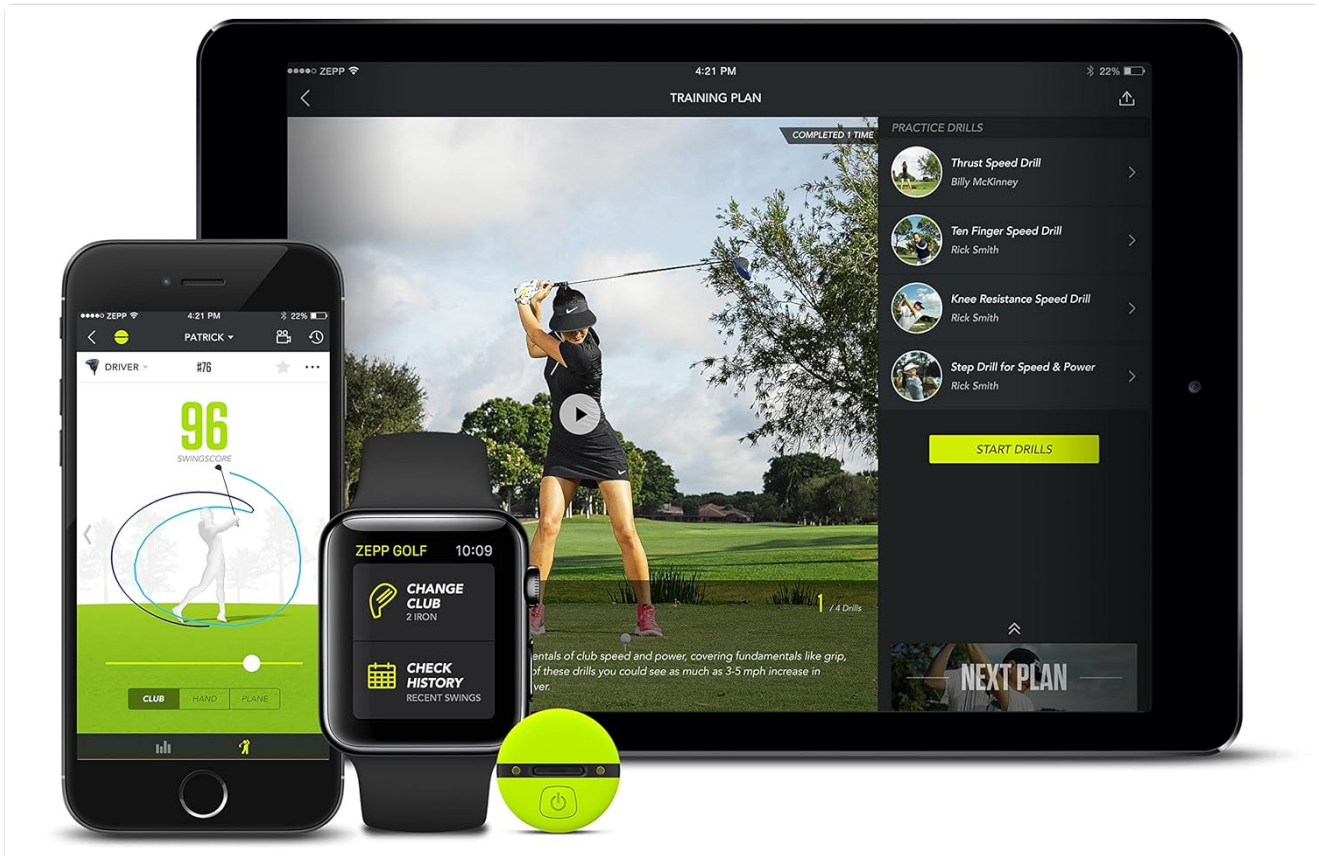

Zepp Golf 2 3D Swing Analyzer User Manual

INTRODUCTION

The Zepp Golf 2 is a state-of-the-art 3D swing analyzer designed to help golfers of all levels improve their game. By attaching the compact sensor to your golf glove, the device captures critical swing data, providing instant feedback and personalized training programs. This manual will guide you through setting up, operating, and maintaining your Zepp Golf 2 to ensure you get the most out of its powerful features.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your Zepp Golf 2, please ensure all the following components are present:

- Zepp 2 Sensor
- Glove Mount
- USB Charger

SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your Zepp Golf 2 for the first time:

1. **Charge the Sensor:** Connect the Zepp 2 Sensor to the provided USB charger. A full charge cycle takes approximately 1.5 hours and provides up to 8 hours of continuous use. The LED indicator on the sensor will show charging status.
2. **Download the Zepp Golf App:** Search for "Zepp Golf" in your device's app store (compatible with iPhone 5 and newer, iPad 3rd Gen and newer, iPod Touch 6th Gen and newer, iPad Mini and newer, running iOS 9 and above). Install the application.
3. **Create an Account:** Open the Zepp Golf app and follow the on-screen instructions to create a new user account or log in if you already have one.
4. **Pair the Sensor:** Ensure your device's Bluetooth is enabled. In the Zepp Golf app, navigate to the device

pairing section. Turn on your Zepp 2 sensor (usually by pressing a button). The app will detect the sensor via Bluetooth LE. Select your sensor from the list to pair it.

5. **Attach the Sensor to your Glove:** Securely attach the Zepp 2 sensor to the back of your golf glove using the provided glove mount. Ensure it is firmly in place and does not interfere with your grip or swing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your Zepp Golf 2 sensor is charged, paired, and attached, you are ready to begin analyzing your swing:

- **Start a Session:** Open the Zepp Golf app. Select the type of session you wish to start (e.g., practice, training).
- **Swing Analysis:** As you take swings, the Zepp 2 sensor will automatically capture data. The app provides instant evaluations of key metrics such as club speed, club plane, tempo, and backswing length. This immediate feedback helps you identify areas for improvement.
- **Smart Coach:** Utilize the Smart Coach feature for personalized training programs. These programs are tailored based on your swing data and are developed by PGA/LPGA players and Tour instructors, designed to help you improve faster.
- **360-Degree Swing Replay:** Review and replay your swing in 360 degrees from any angle within the app. This visual feedback is crucial for understanding your swing mechanics.
- **HD Video Recording:** The app allows you to record your swing in HD video. You can then compare your swing directly to professional golfers or your own past swings to track progress.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your Zepp Golf 2 sensor:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the sensor and glove mount with a soft, dry cloth after each use to remove dirt or sweat. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the sensor in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the sensor frequently. If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to about 50% before storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Zepp Golf 2, try the following solutions:

- **Sensor Not Connecting:**
 - Ensure the sensor is charged and powered on.
 - Verify Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device.
 - Close and reopen the Zepp Golf app.
 - Restart your mobile device.
 - Try re-pairing the sensor through the app's settings.
- **Inaccurate Readings:**

- Ensure the sensor is securely attached to the glove and not moving during the swing.
- Check for any obstructions between the sensor and your mobile device.
- Ensure your app is updated to the latest version.
- **Battery Draining Quickly:**
 - Ensure the sensor is fully charged before use.
 - Close the app when not in use to prevent background activity.
 - Reduce the distance between the sensor and your mobile device during use.
