INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper installation and maintenance of your Bauknecht Oven Cooker Door Seal Gasket (1045mm). INSTALLATION

Replacing your oven door seal gasket is a straightforward process. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Preparation:** Ensure the oven is completely cool and disconnected from the power supply. Open the oven door fully.
2. **Remove Old Gasket:** Carefully pull the old gasket away from the oven frame. Most gaskets are held in place by clips or hooks that fit into small holes around the oven door opening. Note how the old gasket was attached to assist with new installation.
3. **Clean Area:** Clean the area around the oven door frame where the gasket sits. Remove any food debris or grease that might prevent a proper seal.
4. **Install New Gasket:** Begin by aligning one corner of the new gasket with a corresponding corner on the oven frame. Gently push the clips or hooks of the new gasket into the holes on the oven frame. Work your way around the entire door opening, ensuring the gasket is securely seated and lies flat against the frame.
5. **Check Fit:** Once installed, gently close the oven door to check the seal. The door should close smoothly, and the gasket should create a snug fit without any gaps.

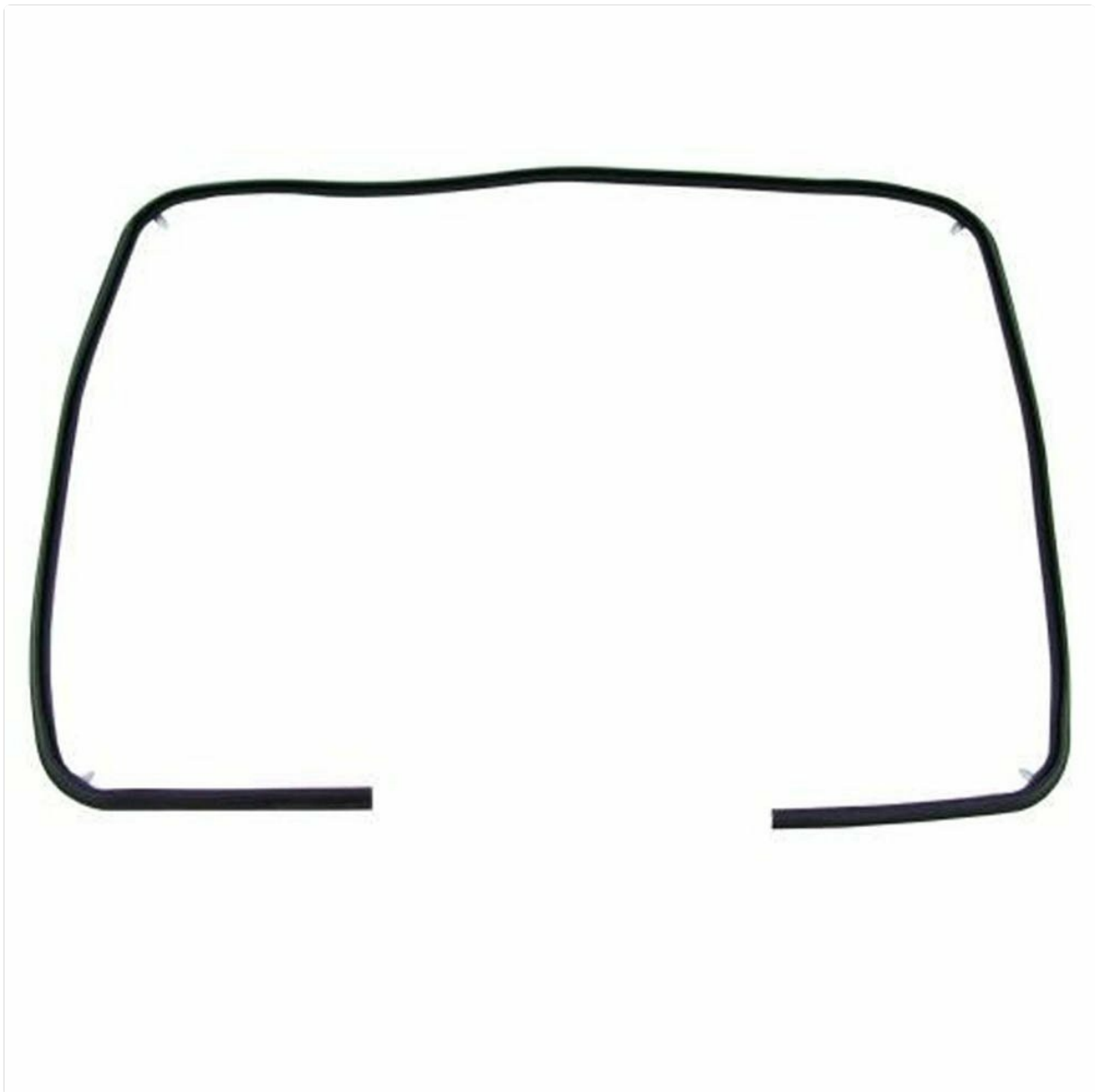

ENSURING PROPER FUNCTION

After installation, it is important to verify the gasket's proper function to ensure optimal oven performance and energy efficiency.

- **Visual Inspection:** Regularly inspect the gasket for any signs of wear, tears, or hardening. A healthy gasket should be pliable and free from visible damage.
- **Door Closure Test:** Close the oven door. It should feel secure and not have any noticeable gaps around the edges. You can perform a "paper test" by placing a piece of paper between the door and the oven frame, then closing the door. If you can easily pull the paper out, the seal might be compromised.
- **Heat Retention Check:** During oven operation, observe if excessive heat is escaping from around the oven door. A properly functioning gasket will minimize heat loss.

MAINTENANCE

To prolong the life of your oven door seal gasket and maintain oven efficiency, follow these maintenance tips:

- **Regular Cleaning:** Wipe down the gasket regularly with a damp cloth and mild detergent to remove food spills and grease. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the rubber material.
- **Avoid Damage:** Be careful not to pinch or tear the gasket when loading or unloading items from the oven.
- **Inspect Periodically:** Periodically check the gasket for any signs of wear, cracks, or stiffness. Replace the gasket if it shows significant signs of degradation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven door not sealing properly / Heat escaping	Gasket is worn, torn, or improperly installed.	Inspect the gasket for damage. Re-seat the gasket if it's loose. Replace the gasket if damaged.
Oven door difficult to close	Gasket is new and stiff, or improperly seated.	Ensure the gasket is fully seated in its channel. With new gaskets, it may take a few uses for the material to soften and conform.
Excessive condensation inside oven door	Poor door seal allowing steam to escape and condense.	Check gasket for damage or improper installation. Replace if necessary.
Gasket falling out of place	Clips/hooks not fully engaged or damaged.	Press the gasket firmly into place, ensuring all clips/hooks are secured. If clips are damaged, the gasket may need replacement.
