Stainless Steel Manual Coffee Grinder with Ceramic Burr

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Zeller 27219 Manual Coffee Grinder. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use, setup, operation, and maintenance of your new coffee grinder. Please read these instructions thoroughly before first use and retain them for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Keep the grinder out of reach of children.
- This appliance is intended for grinding roasted coffee beans only. Do not use it for other substances, as this may damage the grinding mechanism or pose a safety risk.
- Avoid contact with moving parts during operation.
- Do not immerse the entire grinder in water or any other liquid.
- Handle the ceramic burr carefully, as it is fragile.
- Ensure all parts are correctly assembled before use.
- Clean the grinder regularly as described in the maintenance section to prevent residue buildup.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Zeller 27219 is a manual coffee grinder featuring a durable stainless steel body and a high-quality ceramic grinding mechanism. It is designed for consistent and adjustable grinding of coffee beans.

Components:

- **Handle:** Detachable crank for manual grinding.
- **Lid:** Covers the bean hopper.
- **Bean Hopper:** Upper chamber for whole coffee beans.
- **Ceramic Burr Grinding Mechanism:** The internal components responsible for grinding.
- **Grind Adjustment Nut:** Located beneath the burr, used to set grind fineness.
- **Ground Coffee Collection Container:** Lower chamber for collecting ground coffee.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the collection container, lid, and handle with warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. The ceramic burr mechanism can be cleaned with a brush.
3. **Assemble:** Ensure the ceramic burr is securely in place. Attach the handle to the top shaft.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Adjusting Grind Size

The Zeller 27219 allows for infinite adjustment of grind fineness, from fine to coarse. To adjust:

1. Remove the handle and the lid.
2. Locate the grind adjustment nut, typically found beneath the ceramic burr.
3. Turn the adjustment nut clockwise for a finer grind and counter-clockwise for a coarser grind. Make small adjustments and test the grind to find your preferred setting.
4. Replace the lid and handle after adjustment.

5.2. Grinding Coffee

1. Ensure the collection container is securely attached to the bottom of the grinder.
2. Open the lid and pour the desired amount of whole coffee beans into the bean hopper. Do not overfill.
3. Replace the lid and attach the handle.
4. Hold the grinder firmly with one hand and turn the handle clockwise with the other hand. Continue turning until all beans have been ground.
5. Remove the collection container to access your freshly ground coffee.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your grinder.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, empty any remaining coffee grounds. Use a small brush (not included) to clean the ceramic burrs and remove any trapped coffee particles.
- **Periodic Deep Cleaning:** Disassemble the grinder by removing the handle, lid, and collection container. Carefully remove the ceramic burr mechanism if possible (refer to product diagrams for specific disassembly). Wash the stainless steel body, lid, and collection container with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- **Ceramic Burr Cleaning:** Do not wash the ceramic burrs with water. Use a dry brush or a soft cloth to remove coffee oils and particles. Ensure the burrs are completely dry before reassembly.
- **Reassembly:** Reassemble all parts once they are completely dry.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Grinder is difficult to turn.	Check if the grind setting is too fine. Adjust to a coarser setting. Ensure no foreign objects are in the hopper.
Inconsistent grind size.	Ensure the grind adjustment nut is tightened correctly. Clean the burrs to remove any buildup that might affect consistency.
No coffee grounds produced.	Check if coffee beans are loaded in the hopper. Verify the burr mechanism is correctly assembled and not loose.
Handle is loose.	Ensure the handle is properly seated on the shaft and secured if applicable.
