1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the AMPIRE DVX104 DVD Player with USB Interface. This compact 3/4 DIN unit is designed to provide versatile media playback in various installations, supporting a wide range of audio and video formats. This manual provides essential information for proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your device. Please read it thoroughly before use.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the device is installed by a qualified professional to prevent damage or injury.
- Do not expose the unit to moisture, rain, or extreme temperatures.
- Disconnect power before performing any maintenance or installation.
- Use only the specified power supply (12V DC).
- Do not block ventilation openings.
- Keep out of reach of children.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4.1 Front Panel

4.2 Remote Control

The included IR remote control provides full functionality, allowing you to control playback, navigate menus, adjust volume, and select input sources from a distance. Ensure the external IR receiver is positioned correctly for optimal signal reception.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The DVX104 is designed for flexible installation, supporting both vertical and horizontal mounting positions. It is a 3/4 DIN size unit, suitable for various integration scenarios, including automotive or home entertainment systems.

5.1 Mounting

1. Choose a suitable location for installation, considering ventilation and accessibility for disc insertion/removal.
2. Use the provided mounting brackets and screws to secure the unit. The unit can be mounted vertically or horizontally.
3. Ensure the mounting surface is stable and can support the unit's weight (approx. 1.6 kg).

5.2 Wiring Connections

- **Power Connection:** Connect the unit to a 12V DC power source. The maximum power consumption is 15W. The unit consumes 0W when the ignition is off.
- **AV Output:** Connect the 1 AV output to your display device (e.g., television, monitor) using appropriate cables. The video signal is 1Vp-p, and the audio signal is 6Vss (2.1V RMS).
- **External IR Receiver:** Plug in the external IR receiver and position it where it has a clear line of sight to your remote control.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Disc Playback

1. Insert a compatible disc (DVD, SVCD, MVCD, MSVCD, VCD1.0/2.0, CD-DA) into the disc slot. The unit will automatically begin playback.
2. Use the remote control or front panel buttons for Play/Pause, Stop, and track navigation.
3. The unit features a "last position memory" function for disc operation, allowing you to resume playback from where you left off (not applicable for MPEG4 files).

6.2 USB Media Playback

1. Insert a USB stick (up to 8GB) or a 2.5-inch hard drive (up to 80GB, FAT32 formatted) into the USB port.
2. If the hard drive is not recognized, it may require an external power supply.
3. Use the "SRC" (Source) button on the front panel or remote to switch to USB input.
4. Navigate through your media files (MPEG4, WMA, MP3, JPEG) using the remote control.

6.3 On-Screen Display (OSD) Menu

The unit features a German on-screen operating menu. Use the remote control's navigation buttons to access and adjust settings such as audio output, video settings, and system preferences.

6.4 Supported Formats

- **Video:** DVD, SVCD, MVCD, MSVCD, VCD1.0, VCD2.0, MPEG4 (Video encoding: MPEG-2)
- **Audio:** WMA, CD-DA, MP3, Dolby Digital Audio format
- **Images:** JPEG

7. MAINTENANCE

- Clean the unit's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Keep the disc slot free from dust and debris.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit to prevent overheating.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Incorrect power connection; Blown fuse	Check 12V DC power supply and connections. Verify fuse.
No disc playback	Disc is dirty or scratched; Incompatible disc format	Clean the disc. Ensure the disc format is supported (DVD, VCD, CD-DA).
USB device not recognized	Incorrect format (not FAT32); Device requires external power; USB device capacity too large	Ensure USB device is FAT32 formatted. For HDDs, try with external power. Check capacity limits (8GB for sticks, 80GB for HDDs).
No remote control response	Batteries are dead; IR receiver blocked or misplaced	Replace remote control batteries. Ensure IR receiver has a clear line of sight to the remote.
No video output	AV cable not connected properly; Incorrect input selected on display device	Check AV cable connections. Select the correct AV input on your television/monitor.
