### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Browning High Noon Spotlight is a durable, rechargeable device designed for various lighting needs. Key features include:

- Powerful white LED light source.
- Multiple lighting modes: High, Low, and Flashing.
- Integrated Power Bank function for charging other USB devices.
- USB rechargeable internal battery.
- Waterproof and submersible design, capable of floating.
- Color-coded battery status and charging indicator.




Image 2: Icons illustrating key features: 110-1400 Lumens, 110-600 Yards distance, 4-36 Hours battery life,

## 4. SETUP AND CHARGING

### 4.1 Initial Charge

Before first use, fully charge the spotlight's internal Li-polymer battery. The battery has a capacity of 3,000 mAh.

1. Locate the waterproof rubber flap covering the USB ports on the rear of the spotlight.
2. Carefully open the rubber flap to expose the 5V IN (charging input) and 5V-1.0A OUT (power bank output) USB ports.

3. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the 5V IN port and plug the other end into a suitable USB power source (e.g., wall adapter, computer USB port).

4. The color-coded indicator will show the charging status. Refer to the indicator guide (usually green for full, red for charging).
5. Once fully charged, disconnect the USB cable and securely close the rubber flap to maintain waterproof integrity.

## **4.2 Power Bank Function**

The spotlight can also be used to charge other USB devices.

1. Open the rubber flap to access the USB ports.
2. Connect your device's USB charging cable to the 5V-1.0A OUT port on the spotlight.

3. The spotlight's internal battery will begin charging your connected device.
4. Monitor your device's charging status. Disconnect when charging is complete and close the rubber flap.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Browning High Noon Spotlight features a single button for controlling its lighting modes.

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button once to turn the spotlight on. Press and hold the power button to turn it off.
2. **Mode Selection:** While the spotlight is on, press the power button repeatedly to cycle through the available modes:
  - **High:** Maximum brightness (915 lumens).
  - **Low:** Reduced brightness for extended runtime.
  - **Flashing:** Strobe mode for signaling or emergencies.
3. **Battery Indicator:** The color-coded indicator light provides an estimate of the remaining battery power.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the spotlight with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Waterproof Seal:** Regularly inspect the rubber flap covering the USB ports for any signs of wear or damage. Ensure it is clean and properly sealed when not in use to maintain its waterproof rating.
- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Recharge the spotlight periodically if it is stored for extended periods.
- **Storage:** Store the spotlight in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Spotlight does not turn on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the spotlight fully.
Spotlight does not charge.	USB cable is faulty or not properly connected. Power source is not active. Internal battery issue.	Ensure USB cable is securely connected and try a different cable. Verify the power source is working. If problem persists, contact customer support.
Power bank function not working.	Spotlight battery is too low. Device cable is faulty or not properly connected.	Charge the spotlight. Ensure the device's USB cable is securely connected to the 5V-1.0A OUT port.


