Introduction



Setup

1. Unpacking:

Carefully remove the watch from its packaging. Inspect for any visible damage.

2. Winding the Watch:

As an automatic watch, it winds itself with the motion of your wrist. However, if the watch has stopped or has not been worn for an extended period, it may require manual winding. To manually wind, unscrew the crown (if applicable) and turn it clockwise approximately 30-40 times until the second hand begins to move smoothly. Do not overwind.

3. **Setting the Time:**

Pull the crown out to the furthest position. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the correct time. Push the crown back in to its original position to start the watch.

4. **Setting the Date:**

Pull the crown out to the middle position. Turn the crown to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement. If the time falls within this period, first adjust the time outside this range, set the date, then reset the time. Push the crown back in to its original position.

5. **Adjusting the Strap:**

Ensure the rubber strap is adjusted for a comfortable and secure fit on your wrist. The foldover clasp with push button ensures easy and secure fastening.

Operating the Automatic Movement

Your Hublot Classic Fusion watch is powered by an automatic mechanical movement. This means it does not require a battery. The movement is powered by the natural motion of your wrist. When worn regularly, the watch will remain wound and keep accurate time. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it will stop and require manual winding and time/date setting before wearing again.

- **Power Reserve:** The watch has a power reserve, typically around 42 hours, meaning it can run for that duration when fully wound and not worn.
- **Daily Wear:** For optimal performance, wear your watch daily for at least 8-10 hours.
- **Winder Compatibility:** If you do not wear your watch regularly, a watch winder can be used to keep it wound. Consult the winder's instructions for proper settings.

Maintenance and Care

- **Cleaning:**
Wipe the watch case and strap regularly with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and fingerprints. For more thorough cleaning, use a slightly damp cloth and mild soap, then dry thoroughly. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Water Resistance:**
While the watch may have some water resistance, it is crucial to ensure the crown is fully pushed in and screwed down (if applicable) before any contact with water. Avoid exposing the watch to hot water, steam, or sudden temperature changes, as this can compromise seals. Refer to the watch's specific water resistance rating for appropriate use (e.g., 50m for splashes, 100m for swimming, etc.).
- **Temperature and Magnetic Fields:**
Avoid exposing your watch to extreme temperatures (below 0°C or above 60°C) or strong magnetic fields, as these can affect the accuracy of the movement.
- **Servicing:**
Mechanical watches require periodic servicing, typically every 3-5 years, to ensure optimal performance and longevity. This involves cleaning, lubricating, and adjusting the movement. Contact an authorized Hublot service center for professional maintenance.

Troubleshooting

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|------------------------------|--|---|
| Watch has stopped. | Insufficient power reserve (not worn enough or not wound). | Manually wind the watch (30-40 turns of the crown) or wear it for several hours. |
| Watch is running slow/fast. | Exposure to magnetic fields, shock, or needs servicing. | Keep away from strong magnets. If persistent, contact an authorized service center for demagnetization or regulation. |
| Date not changing correctly. | Date set during restricted hours (9 PM - 3 AM) or mechanical issue. | Avoid setting date during restricted hours. If issue persists, seek professional service. |
| Condensation under crystal. | Water ingress due to compromised seals or extreme temperature changes. | Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center to prevent further damage. |
