INTRODUCTION

The Logitech Z130 compact 2.0 stereo speakers are designed to provide rich, clear stereo sound with convenient controls and easy setup. With 5 watts of total power, these speakers deliver strong audio performance for various multimedia needs. They connect to your device via a standard 3.5mm plug and feature a headphone jack and accessible volume controls for personalized listening.

SETUP

Setting up your Logitech Z130 speakers is straightforward:

- 1. **Connect the Speakers:** Locate the 3.5mm audio cable extending from one of the speaker units. Plug this cable into the 3.5mm audio output jack on your computer, laptop, or other compatible audio device.
- 2. Connect Power: Plug the power adapter of the speakers into a standard electrical outlet.
- 3. **Position Speakers:** Place the two speaker units on either side of your monitor or listening area for optimal stereo sound. They are compact and designed to fit nicely on a desk.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once set up, operating your Logitech Z130 speakers is simple:

- Power On/Off: The main speaker unit features a power button, often integrated with the volume knob. Turn the volume knob clockwise to power on the speakers; turn it counter-clockwise until it clicks to power off. A green LED indicator will illuminate when the speakers are on.
- **Adjust Volume:** Use the large 'VOL' knob on the front of the main speaker to adjust the audio volume. Turn clockwise to increase volume, counter-clockwise to decrease.
- **Headphone Jack:** For private listening, plug your headphones into the 3.5mm headphone jack located on the front of the main speaker unit. This will mute the speakers and route audio through your headphones.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Logitech Z130 speakers, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the speaker surfaces. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or strong chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- **Dust Removal:** Gently brush away any dust from the speaker grilles using a soft brush or a can of compressed air.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the speakers in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Cable Care: Avoid sharply bending or crimping the audio and power cables. Ensure they are not tangled or placed where they can be tripped over.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Logitech Z130 speakers, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

No sound	Speakers not powered on; Volume too low; Incorrect audio connection; Device audio settings.	Ensure speakers are powered on (green LED lit). Increase volume. Check 3.5mm audio cable connection to both speakers and audio source. Verify audio output settings on your computer/device.
Distorted sound	Volume too high; Poor audio source quality; Loose connection.	Lower the volume on both speakers and your audio source. Try a different audio source to check if the issue persists. Ensure all cables are securely connected.
Only one speaker working	Loose connection; Balance settings on audio source.	Check the connection between the two speaker units. Verify the audio balance settings on your computer or audio device.
