


Image: The Polaris P825 Robotic Pool Cleaner operating underwater, demonstrating its cleaning action.

#### **M**AINTENANCE

- **Poor Cleaning Performance:** Clean the filter canister thoroughly. Check if the pool water chemistry is balanced. Ensure the cleaner is operating for the full cycle duration.
- Cleaner Not Climbing Walls: Verify the Surface Control System™ settings are appropriate for your pool surface. Check for excessive algae or slick spots on pool walls.
- Cable Tangling: Ensure the cable is fully uncoiled before placing the cleaner in the pool. The swivel cable is designed to minimize tangling, but manual untangling may occasionally be required.
- Cleaner Stuck: If the cleaner gets stuck on a drain or obstacle, gently reposition it.


