1. INTRODUCTION

This high-quality sink, crafted from durable Cristadur material with an elegant bronze finish, is designed for seamless integration into your kitchen countertop. This manual provides essential information for safe installation, proper operation, and effective maintenance to ensure long-lasting performance and satisfaction.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) such as safety glasses and gloves during installation.

- Ensure the installation area is well-lit and free from obstructions.
- Turn off the main water supply before beginning any plumbing work.
- If you are unsure about any part of the installation process, consult a qualified professional plumber or installer.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals on the sink surface, as this may damage the Cristadur material and bronze finish.
- Keep small children and pets away from the work area during installation.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged before proceeding with installation. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact your retailer immediately.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section provides detailed instructions for installing your built-in kitchen sink. Ensure you have all necessary tools and materials before starting.

4.1 Tools and Materials Required

- Jigsaw or appropriate cutting tool for countertop material
- Drill (possibly with a diamond core drill bit for specific materials)
- Measuring tape and pencil
- Silicone sealant (kitchen and bath grade)
- Screwdriver
- Adjustable wrench
- Safety glasses and gloves

4.2 Countertop Preparation and Cut-out

1. Carefully place the provided installation template on your countertop in the desired location. Ensure adequate clearance from cabinets and walls.
2. Trace the outline of the template onto the countertop using a pencil.
3. Using a jigsaw or appropriate cutting tool, carefully cut along the traced line. For precise measurements, refer to the technical drawing below.
4. Smooth any rough edges of the cut-out.




Figure 3: Technical drawing of the Schock MOND100FBBRO sink with key dimensions. This diagram illustrates the top-down and cross-sectional views, showing overall length (765 mm / 30.11 inches), width (510 mm / 20.07 inches), bowl depth (305 mm / 12.00 inches), and other critical measurements for accurate countertop cut-out and installation.

4.3 Sink Installation

1. Apply a continuous bead of silicone sealant around the perimeter of the countertop cut-out.
2. Carefully lower the sink into the cut-out, ensuring it is properly aligned.
3. From underneath the countertop, attach the mounting clips to the sink rim and tighten them evenly to secure the sink in place. Do not overtighten.
4. Wipe away any excess silicone sealant immediately.

4.4 Plumbing Connections

1. Install the drain assembly according to its specific instructions, ensuring all seals are properly seated to prevent leaks.
2. Connect the P-trap and waste pipe to the drain assembly.
3. If installing a faucet, follow the faucet manufacturer's instructions to mount it to the sink or countertop and connect the water supply lines.
4. Once all connections are made, turn on the main water supply and check for any leaks. Tighten connections as necessary.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Schock MOND100FBBRO sink is designed for everyday kitchen use. Its Cristadur material is highly resistant to scratches, impacts, and heat.

- Use the sink for washing dishes, preparing food, and other typical kitchen tasks.
- Ensure the drain stopper is properly seated when filling the sink with water.
- Avoid pouring extremely hot liquids (e.g., boiling oil) directly onto the sink surface without running cold water simultaneously, although Cristadur is highly heat resistant.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will help maintain the beauty and longevity of your Schock Cristadur sink.

6.1 Daily Cleaning

- After each use, rinse the sink thoroughly with water to remove food particles and residue.
- Wipe the sink dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots, especially in hard water areas.
- For general cleaning, use a mild dish soap and a soft sponge or cloth.

6.2 Deep Cleaning and Stain Removal

- For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cream cleaner specifically designed for composite sinks. Apply with a soft cloth, rub gently, and rinse thoroughly.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive pads, steel wool, or bleach-based cleaners, as these can damage the Cristadur surface and bronze finish.
- For limescale deposits, use a diluted vinegar solution or a specialized limescale remover, following the product instructions and rinsing well.

6.3 Preventing Damage

- Avoid dropping heavy or sharp objects into the sink, which could cause chipping or cracking.
- Do not place hot pots or pans directly onto the sink surface without protection, although Cristadur is heat resistant, extreme thermal shock should be avoided.
- Prevent prolonged contact with highly acidic or alkaline substances. Rinse immediately if contact occurs.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your sink.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage	Loose plumbing connections, faulty seals, improper sealant application.	Check and tighten all plumbing connections. Inspect drain assembly seals and re-seal if necessary. Ensure silicone sealant around the sink rim is intact.
Slow Drainage	Clogged drain, debris in the P-trap.	Remove the drain stopper and clear any visible debris. Disassemble and clean the P-trap if necessary. Use a drain cleaner suitable for plumbing systems (avoid harsh chemicals if possible).
Water Spots/Limescale	Hard water deposits, not drying the sink after use.	Wipe the sink dry after each use. Use a diluted vinegar solution or a specialized limescale remover for existing deposits.
Dull Surface/Stains	Accumulated grime, improper cleaning agents.	Clean regularly with mild soap and water. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive composite sink cleaner. Avoid abrasive pads or harsh chemicals.
