1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The TensCare Liberty Plus Vaginal Probe is a high-quality, reusable probe designed for use with electro-stimulators and EMG biofeedback equipment. It is specifically developed for pelvic floor muscle training to address conditions such as female urinary incontinence.

This probe features a 32mm diameter, making it slightly wider than the standard Liberty probe, and is designed for comfortable and effective intravaginal use.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before use. Failure to do so may result in injury or improper device function.

- Do not use this probe if you have a copper Intrauterine Device (IUD).
- If you experience allergic reactions to metals such as steel, a gold-plated probe (e.g., TensCare Gold Vaginal Probe) may be a more suitable alternative.
- Consult your healthcare professional before using this device, especially if you have any pre-existing medical conditions.
- This device is intended for intravaginal use only.
- Keep out of reach of children.



3. SETUP AND CONNECTION

- Preparation:** Ensure the probe is clean and dry before each use. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for proper cleaning procedures.
- Lubrication:** Apply a water-based lubricant to the tip of the probe for easier and more comfortable insertion.
- Connection:** Connect the 2mm pin connectors of the probe's lead wires to your compatible electro-stimulator or EMG biofeedback device. Ensure a secure connection.
- Insertion:** Gently insert the probe into the vagina. The ergonomic design and smooth surface facilitate comfortable insertion.




Image 3: Compatibility. This image illustrates the 2mm pin connectors, confirming compatibility with most pelvic floor exercise devices, including TensCare models.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The TensCare Liberty Plus Vaginal Probe is designed to be used with an approved electro-stimulator or EMG biofeedback device for pelvic floor muscle training. Always follow the specific operating instructions provided with your primary device.

General Usage Guidelines:

1. Once the probe is inserted and connected, turn on your electro-stimulator or biofeedback device.
2. Select the appropriate program or settings on your device as recommended by your healthcare professional or the device's manual.
3. Adjust the intensity gradually to a comfortable level. You should feel a gentle contraction or sensation, not pain.
4. Perform your pelvic floor exercises as instructed by your healthcare professional or the device's program.
5. After each session, turn off your device and carefully remove the probe.

This probe is particularly effective for stimulating, toning, and strengthening pelvic muscles, and can help

soothe bladder muscles to reduce urinary leakage.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper maintenance and cleaning are essential for the hygiene and longevity of your TensCare Liberty Plus Vaginal Probe.

- After Each Use:** Disconnect the probe from the device. Wash the probe thoroughly with mild soap and warm water.
- Rinsing:** Rinse the probe completely under running water to remove all soap residue.
- Drying:** Dry the probe thoroughly with a clean, lint-free cloth or allow it to air dry completely before storage.
- Storage:** Store the probe in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Do Not:** Do not boil, sterilize, or use abrasive cleaners on the probe.

The product has an approximate lifespan of 6 months, depending on the frequency of use. Replace the probe after this period or if any signs of wear or damage are observed.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sensation or Weak Sensation:**

- Check that the probe is securely connected to your device.
- Ensure the device is turned on and the intensity is set to an appropriate level.
- Verify that the probe is inserted correctly and making good contact.
- Ensure sufficient water-based lubricant has been used.
- Check the battery level of your electro-stimulator.

- **Discomfort or Pain:**

- Reduce the intensity setting on your device immediately.
- Ensure adequate lubrication.
- Re-position the probe for comfort.
- If discomfort persists, discontinue use and consult your healthcare professional.

- **Probe Damage:**

- Inspect the probe and lead wires for any visible signs of damage (cracks, frayed wires).
- If damaged, discontinue use and replace the probe.


Image 6: Ergonomic Design. This image illustrates the ergonomic shape of the probe, designed for comfortable vaginal use and easy insertion.
