1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your HTC 10 smartphone. Please read it thoroughly before operating your device.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX


Verify that all items are present in the product packaging:

- HTC 10 Smartphone
- USB Cable
- Charger (may be foreign, a FREE US adapter will be included if so)
- Documentation (User Manual, Safety Guide)

3. SETUP

3.1. Inserting SIM Card and microSD Card

Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the device. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray. Insert your Nano-SIM card and, if desired, a microSD card into their respective slots on the tray. Ensure the cards are correctly oriented before reinserting the tray into the phone.






Figure 2: HTC 10 Side View. This image displays the right side of the HTC 10, where the power button and volume rocker are located. The SIM/microSD card tray is typically on the opposite side or top/bottom, but this view helps visualize the phone's profile.

3.2. Initial Power On and Setup Wizard

Press and hold the power button located on the right side of the device until the HTC logo appears. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, Google account sign-in, and security settings.

4. OPERATING YOUR HTC 10

4.1. Display and Navigation

The HTC 10 features a 5.2-inch Super LCD5 capacitive touchscreen. Navigation is primarily touch-based. Use gestures such as tap, swipe, pinch-to-zoom, and long-press. The device includes capacitive navigation buttons below the screen for Back, Home, and Recent Apps.

4.2. Camera Operation

Your HTC 10 is equipped with a 12 MP main camera (f/1.8, 26mm, OIS, laser autofocus, dual-LED flash) and a 5 MP front camera. To open the camera app, tap the camera icon on the home screen or lock screen. Tap the screen to focus, and press the shutter button to capture photos. Swipe left or right to switch between photo and video modes.

4.3. Connectivity

The HTC 10 supports various connectivity options:

- Wi-Fi: Connect to wireless networks for internet access.
- Bluetooth: Pair with wireless accessories like headphones or speakers.
- USB: Connect to a computer for data transfer or charging.
- GSM Cellular: Compatible with GSM carriers such as AT&T and T-Mobile. Note: This is an
 international model and may not support LTE in the USA.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of your HTC 10. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the device's finish. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water.

5.2. Battery Care

The HTC 10 contains a non-removable Lithium Ion battery. To prolong battery life, avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures. Charge the device using only the provided charger and USB cable. Avoid completely draining the battery frequently.

5.3. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Updates can be found in the device's settings menu under "About phone" or "System updates."

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Solution |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| Device not powering on | Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again. |
| Poor network signal or no service | Check if your SIM card is properly inserted. Verify that your cellular carrier supports the bands for this international model. Restart the device. |
| Applications crashing or freezing | Close and reopen the application. Clear the app's cache in settings. If the issue persists, restart the phone. |
| Battery drains quickly | Reduce screen brightness, disable unused features like Wi-Fi or Bluetooth, and close background apps. |


